

RE: WARN NOTICE OF PERMANENT PLANT CLOSING

Dear Ms. Long and Mayor Henry:

This notice is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (the WARN Act). Unfortunately, due to legitimate business concerns, American Medical Response Ambulance Service, Inc. ("AMR") has decided to cease all operations and permanently close the facility located at 525 Hayden Street, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46802, which will result in a permanent layoff of all employees who are currently employed at the Fort Wayne facility.

This will be a permanent closure of the entire plant and it is anticipated to occur on June 30, 2009, which will also be the date of separation of employment for the affected Fort Wayne employees. The layoffs will be permanent and no bumping or transfer rights exist with respect to the Fort Wayne employees. However, all Fort Wayne employees are free to reapply for positions with AMR in accordance with AMR policy, and in certain circumstances, employees who accept positions at another AMR operation may be entitled to receive certain relocation benefits pursuant to current AMR policy.
