

HOW TO BECOME A WORKINDIANA TRAINING PROVIDER



Requirements:

Resources:

- Provider location and program **approved and fundable** on INTraining ETPL; and
- Result in an WorkINDiana recognized credential; and
- Accept students who do not have a high school diploma or its equivalent but who are pursuing one through an Adult Education program; and
- Training must be 14 weeks or less and 40 hours or more; and
- Agrees to 70/30 payment split

- ⇒ INTraining and WorkINDiana applications must be submitted for each location, each program
- ⇒ Must submit INTraining and WorkINDiana data separately
 - INTraining: INTraining Data Entry Portal
 - WorkINDiana: WorkINDiana Portal
- ⇒ If a provider or program is removed from ETPL fundable status, the program will also be automatically removed from approved WorkINDiana status
- ⇒ If a provider or program becomes fundable on ETPL again, a new WorkINDiana application will be required

WorkINDiana Training Provider

WorkINDiana has adopted the INTraining performance and demand criteria. To be eligible to apply as a WorkINDiana training provider, the training provider and program must be INTraining ETPL approved and fundable first.
