If you meet the program eligibility requirements and are accepted into the program you will receive training at no cost to you that will prepare you to earn your **CAPRC I (Certified Addiction Peer Recovery Coach)** credential, **CHW/CRS (Community Health Worker/Certified Recovery Specialist)** certification or **CHW/OWEP (Community Health Worker/Opioid Workforce Expansion)** certification. Following earning your credential or certificate you will have an opportunity to be placed in paid temporary disaster relief employment with the potential to be hired as a Peer Recovery Coach with a local organization serving the recovery community.
