## FAFSA Application Process

- Submit FAFSA after October 1
- State of Indiana: FAFSA must be <u>received</u> on or before **April 15th** to be considered for state-based aid (extended to May 15<sup>th</sup> for the 2021-22 FAFSA due to COVID-19)

Some institutions require students to complete additional application requirements, such as:

- College Scholarship Service (CSS) Profile Form
- Institutional financial aid applications



- Option to transfer parent info if multiple students



## Federal Aid (Title IV)

#### Awarded primarily on basis of financial need

- Grants
  - Federal Pell Grant
  - Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG)
  - TEACH Grant
- Federal Work-Study (FWS)
  - Earn money to use for educational expenses
  - College determines eligibility requirements
    - Amounts subject to change annually

#### Educational Loans for 21-22 FAFSA Year

Subsidized or Unsubsidized Federal Direct Loan
(2.73% rate 4.057% fee)

(3.73% rate, 1.057% fee)

Federal Direct Parent (PLUS) Loan

(6.28% rate, 4.228% fee)

Federal loan rates/fees subject to change annually

All educational loans MUST be repaid. Read the fine print/choose wisely before making a decision Private Lenders also offer educational loans.

Terms and interest rates vary



## Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

- Maintain a 2.0 Cumulative GPA
- Maintain a 67% Completion Rate
- Complete your program within the Maximum Time Frame (MTF)
  - 150% of posted hours for current program
  - TC and CT programs have a smaller MTF than AS/AAS programs





## Dropping vs Withdraw

#### Drop

(during refund period)

Reduces tuition charges; state aid reduces by same amount

#### Withdraw

(after refund period)

Tuition still charged, state aid doesn't adjust
Future year federal and state aid eligibility based on
completed credits
