2	to order the East Chicago Waterway Management
3	District, Board of Director's meeting. Todays date
4	is August 21st, 2019. The time if 5:10 p.m We're
5	running a little behind schedule. Roll Call. John
6	Bakota?
7	MR. BAKOTA: Yes.
8	MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?
9	MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.
10	MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?
11	MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Yes.
12	MR. FEKETE: Ted Zagar?

18	MR. FEKETE: John Fekete? Yes. We have a
19	quorum.
20	The Executive Director's Report,
21	Mr. Trevino.
22	MR. TREVINO: Yes, I'd like to start off
23	by reviewing the contents of your Board packet. You
24	have the Board minutes for July 17th, 2019.
25	You have the CliftonLarsonAllen

1 financial statements for July 31, 2019. You have 2 the Claim Docket dated August 21, 2019. You have an 3 e-mail from myself -- well, couple of e-mail -- from myself to the State Board of Accounts, to Nick 4 5 Canham, just transmitting some of the documentation that was requested from us and signed by either 6 7 myself or the president of the Board, John Fekete or 8 the treasurer, Mr. Ray Lopez. And the e-mail, one 9 e-mail dated June 27th of this year, with Form 13 10 and a summary of our notes that they requested. 11 Also a Form 13 that I sent Mr. Canham and signed on behalf of the District. The other one is an e-mail 12 13 dated July 29th, forwarding exit conference Form 4 14 and Form 31, to Mr. Canham, of the State Board of 15 Accounts. Also, there is a letter that was signed by myself and Mr. Ray Lopez dated July 25, 2019, and 16 that was Form 31. 17 18 There is also a proposal from 19 MapleTronics for doing work on our copier/scanner. 20 You also have in your packet the third modification to the Great Lakes Legacy Act 21 22 Project Agreement, and along with it, an attachment 23 of revised Statement of Work and -- actually both 24 contracts and the attachment are dated August 21,

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2019.

1 You also have a copy of a Toll 2 Agreement between the District and the U.S. Army 3 Corps of Engineers. You have BMO Harris Bank ECI 4 5 Facility Trust report dated July 31, 2019. And you also have BMO Harris Bank report for account ending 6 7 in 712, for the month of July 2019. You have a 8 Letter of Direction to BMO Harris Bank, to Mr. David 9 Alonzo, regarding leaving \$500,000 balance in the 10 Money Market account and transferring the balance to 11 a 11-month CD. And that letter is dated 12 August 21st. 13 You have First Merchant Bank 14 statements ending in 608 and 616 for the month of 15 July 2019. And also a copy of the checks that were cashed under account 608. You also have a report 16 for our 12-month CD with First Merchants and 17 24-month CD with First Merchants, and they are both 18 19 dated August 14th. 20 You have a letter from First 21 Merchants to the Waterway Management District 22 talking about Certificate of Deposit account 23 pre-renewal notice. Mr. Freyek of First Merchants 24 Bank is here to elaborate on that. 25 You have two reports from

People's Bank. One is titled, ArclerMittal Tipping
Fee Escrow and the other is ArclerMittal Dredging
Escrow. And they are both for the second quarter of
2019 and account ending in 301.
You have U.S. Army Corps of
Engineers report to the Board dated August 21, 2019.
You have a letter from the Army Corps of Engineers
dated July 17, 2019, regarding the Dredging Project,
and that's from Colonel Reisinger.
You have Attorney Ellen
Gregory's report to the Board dated August 21, 2019.
And you have a weekly report
from Stantec dated August 9, 2019, regarding
Atlantic Richfield Pipeline Decommissioning Project
in the south tank farm. And that concludes the
items in your Board packet.
Just to kind of go over a couple
items, review the action items on your list I
mean on your agenda. We have the Board minutes for
last month's board meeting, July 17, 2019. The
Claim Docket is on agenda for approval, August 21,
2019. You have the MapleTronics proposal for IT
work in your packet for approval consideration. The
third modification of Great Lakes Legacy Act Project
Agreement in your packet. There is a Tolling

Agreement with the Army Corps of Engineers. 1 2 then there is approval consideration for direction of funds in the BMO Money Market account. That 3 concludes the action items in your Board packet. 4 5 Just a couple of things to give you an update on. We continue to collect the 2019 6 User Fees. We have collected all but three 7 accounts, and of the three account, two of them are 8 9 reaching out to me and making payments. And their 10 intent is to pay their unpaid balance. And the third one is M & M Management, which we have the 11 12 agreed judgment with, and they have been also paying 13 their balance. But I think when we had issues with 14 the U.S. Mail -- which we have got resolved -- might 15 have been part of us not receiving their checks. I need to reach out to them to make sure that they 16 17 are still committed to paying their balance. Mr. Mike Nguyen is in attendance 18 19 to give an update on the Dredging Project. 20 Great Lakes Legacy Act Project, the project team has 21 been working hard on trying to finalize the third 22 modification of the of the Project Agreement, which are in your packet. 23 24 We are still working on 25 finalizing the Cost Share Agreement with Atlantic

1	Richfield/BP. So we are pretty close on finalizing
2	that agreement.
3	We are recommending that the
4	Board approve these documents, the third
5	modification of the Project Agreement, and just hold
6	off signing them until the Cost Share Agreement is
7	finalized and approved.
8	Attorney Ellen Gregory will be
9	giving an update on various legal matters.
10	And I met with Mayor Copeland
11	couple weeks ago, giving him an update on our
12	projects, so that went well. And that is the update
13	for me.
14	Just one other item, Mr. Tim
15	Anderson will be giving a summary of our taxes that
16	need to be signed and submitted for 2018. That
17	concludes my report.
18	MR. FEKETE: Any questions for Mr.
19	Trevino?
20	MR. LOPEZ: Yes, I have one. What about
21	that meeting with Chamber of Commerce?
22	MR. TREVINO: I'll bring that up under New
23	Business.
24	MR. FEKETE: And your meeting with the
25	Mayor, did you have an opportunity to show him the

1	picture of what the Army Corps was going to do?
2	MR. TREVINO: That was part of the agenda
3	items. I gave him an update that the Army Corps of
4	Engineers was working on putting a beautification
5	wall so to speak along Indianapolis Boulevard.
6	What was there in the past was a chain-link fence.
7	And Mr. Gwin, the project manager for the Army
8	Corps, showed pictures on what they intended to
9	install and I shared that with the Mayor. He was
10	very pleased with what they were doing along the CDF
11	property.
12	MR. FEKETE: Thank you. Any other
13	questions? (None).
14	The next order of business is
15	the approval consideration of the Board meeting
16	notes for July 17th.
17	MR. BAKOTA: Motion to approve.
18	MR. LOPEZ: Second.
19	MR. FEKETE: All in favor, signify by
20	saying aye?
21	(All signified aye.)
22	MR. FEKETE: Motion carries.
23	Next we have our Accounting
24	Consultant report, Mr. Anderson.
25	MR. ANDERSON: Tim Anderson, with 9

1 CliftonLarsonAllen. You have our report through 2 July. Page 2 shows for the seven months, ending July 31st, the cash receipts that have come in, 3 interest income, User Fees, and the transfer from 4 5 the Facility Trust, and our list of disbursements by budget line. So our cash has increased from January 6 7 through July 408,000. Cash balance, and this is User Fees, our budgeted checking account, 3.3 8 9 million at the beginning of the year, and 3.7 10 million as of July 31st. And you can see there at the bottom how it breaks out; 841 in our Operating 11 12 account and 845 in the User Fee account. And then 13 we've got those CDs now at 2,049,000. 14 The next page with numbers on it 15 is page 3, and that just shows the monthly activity of those accounts. I do want to point out again, 16 down at the bottom, in that Certificate of Deposit 17

down at the bottom, in that Certificate of Deposit area, 37,000 in interest from January through July.

That was a good call, that pays for your accountant.

That was good decision.

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So last page is page 4, and this shows the budget and what we have spent. So there was a budget amendment, just to keep it exciting.

We added another 33,250 and that all came from the User Fee account. So our total budget for the year

is one million fifty. Only spent 210 through July and then you have your Claims Docket today, and then the unused budget after today.

So we watch to make sure there is no line that's close or we have gone over.

That's the rules. So we watch really closely and make sure we are not getting close or that there is any negative.

So we have 784,000 in the budget remaining for the year, and that roughly equates -- not roughly -- is exactly the balance of our budget checking account. Any questions on this report?

so we did conclude our audit with the State Board. Ellen and Fernando worked tirelessly with that. This is the second audit in a row and we have absolutely no comments, not that we want to start getting cocky. Everything seems to be going well. He had some things that he brought up and some policies -- as we recall -- we passed the policy on internal control at last meeting. As far as writing us for things, he had nothing, which is a testament to Fernando and Ellen's diligence on following the rules and making sure contracts are approved and things like that. So I think you guys

1 should feel confident in that. 2 And then I have a Form 1041 3 today for signature, approval, or whatever. It's the form where we send to the Internal Revenue that 4 5 this is our interest that we earned for the year, and that it's all exempt because we are a 6 7 governmental entity. So we file a form with the government to just memorialize that interest did 8 9 come in, but that it's nontaxable. 10 MR. FEKETE: We talked about this briefly. 11 This doesn't require Board approval. It's part of 12 your service agreement with doing it. 13 It's all very mundane. MR. ANDERSON: 14 one year they left the exemption part off and they 15 wanted taxes on that interest income, which we had to write to them and say, well, no, it's all exempt 16 17 per Section 108. But we file that each year just to keep ourselves current with the IRS. You guys have 18 19 any questions on any of that stuff? 20 MR. LOPEZ: For the record, I want to say 21 thanks to this guy for being so thorough. 22 MR. ANDERSON: We had an objective in the

MR. ANDERSON: We had an objective in the beginning when we first started this to make sure things would be running by the book. And so far, so good.

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1	MR. LOPEZ: With the State Board	
2	of Accounts, they send me so much crap. I don't	
3	know what it is.	
4	MR. ANDERSON: They are changing their	
5	format of filing this year.	
6	MR. TREVINO: The other thing about the	
7	two audits, as Tim mentioned, the one before this	
8	one was for five-years and this one was like a	
9	four-year audit. So basically there is nine years	
10	of audit where they had no comments on our	
11	practices.	
12	MS. GREGORY: But they are being very	
13	careful to say it is not an audit.	
L 4	MR. ANDERSON: It's a review. And what	
15	worries me is, that nothing can get really out of	
16	whack when they only audit every once in awhile.	
17	There is really you know there is always a	
18	risk that you are doing something different and you	
19	should have been doing it at year one. So it's all	
20	good. We are happy about the findings. He said he	
21	would publish something formal in September, I	
22	think.	
23	MS. GREGORY: By mid September.	
24	MR. ANDERSON: So we can hang it on our	
25	walls. Thank you.	1.0

16	MR. LOPEZ: I make a motion we change that
17	3 years, to 3 years to 5 years.
18	MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: You have to be
19	specific with the years.
20	MR. TREVINO: Three to five.
21	MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: I understand what
22	he's saying is that he wants to modify the language
23	from three to to include three to five, that's
24	what he's saying.
25	MR. LOPEZ: That's the same things.

1	MR. FEKETE: I'll entertain a motion for
2	what I said.
3	MR. TREVINO: Could you restate your
4	motion, please?
5	MR. FEKETE: To include in Section 4.2,
6	that deals with invasive species, where it talks
7	about length of time. We are going to change it
8	from up to three years to say, anywhere from 3 to
9	5 years.
10	I'm looking for a motion. I
11	repeated it for clarification purposes, but I need
12	to go back and have a motion to approve the new
13	language.

15	with change in language.

13	MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.
14	MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?
15	MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

20	Next order of business is BMO
21	Harris Bank Trust report, Mr. Alonzo.
22	MR. ALONZO: David Alonzo, BMO Harris.
23	All right. So, you know, to go through this report.
24	Of course first page is the chart showing the
25	historical balances.

The top of the second page,
July 31st, value of the Trust was 4,742,387. That
was a positive difference from our last meeting of
14,914 worth of interest. And then that far column
there shows the total disbursements from '19, were
\$240,038.

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Take a look at the last page. So all the different color coordinated things. The yellow has been the last two CDs that matured. The 33-month CD is the one that just matured on July 25th. That money was deposited to the top account, which is the Money Market. The total balance in that Money Market, as the end of July 31st, was 2,979,140. And the reason why that balance is so high is because we did wait till this July CD finally did mature. We added that, along with the June CD that matured. We held that in the Money Market and now we are at the point where the objective is to keep about \$500,000 in that Money Market. We discussed then putting the remaining balance of anything above half million dollars in the Money Market, into new 11-month CD at 2.1 percent. As we talked, the rate came down right now, the short-term rate, which will allow that money to mature in July of next year, beyond the

1	difference in the value from those CDs maturing.	
2	Some of the interest we made, so	
3	that 14,000, is from the interest from the CD	
4	that just matured, along with the other ones that	
5	made good, which were the 18-month CD that we have	
6	existing right now.	
7	Was there any questions on that	
8	statement?	
9	MR. FEKETE: No questions. Thank you very	
10	much.	
11	Next order of business is to	
12	approve what Mr. Alonzo had stated, that our	
13	agreement was to direct the funds in the Money	
14	Market to go the money we had the in Money Market	
15	to invest into CD, with the exception of \$500,000	
16	that would be held in our Money Market. So that's	
17	11-month	
18	MR. ALONZO: 11-month CD at 2.1 percent.	
19	MR. FEKETE: Okay. Entertain a motion to	
20	approve that request.	
21	MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Motion to approve.	
22	MR. LOPEZ: Second.	
23	MR. FEKETE: Roll call vote. John Bakota?	
24	MR. BAKOTA: Yes.	
25	MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?	
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1	MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.
2	MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?
3	MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Yes.
4	MR. FEKETE: Ray Lopez?
5	MR. LOPEZ: Yes.
6	MR. FEKETE: John Fekete? I vote yes.
7	Motion carries.
8	Next order of business is the
9	First Merchants Reports.
10	MR. FREYEK: John Freyek for First
11	Merchants Bank. I apologize, it's been so long
12	since I have seen you all. I had a conflict with a
13	Board meeting in Valparaiso at the same time.
14	That's been changed, so you will see more of me. I
15	don't know if that's good or not, but you will.
16	Mr. Anderson sort of gave a
17	breakdown earlier and I'll just repeat, presently
18	there is at First Merchants a 855,000 balance in the
19	Money Market account, 841,000 in the checking.
20	There are two CDs, each with just slightly over a
21	million dollars in them. Fernando made reference to
22	a renewal of the one million dollar one-year CD,
23	which it automatically renewed at a very low rate.
24	That has been fixed. Fernando informed me of that
25	and we ordered it to be adjusted. The rate will be

1	2.15 percent retroactive to the renewal date.	
2	Not a lot of activity. You have	
3	two large CDs and you are making good interest on	
4	both, 2.15 for the next year on the one million and	
5	then you still have the 2.72, 2.75 on the	
6	additional.	
7	MR. FEKETE: Okay, very good. Thank you	
8	very much for your response to our concern.	
9	MR. FREYEK: Well, I was shocked and we	
10	addressed it. For future reference, I am going to	
11	get notified as the maturity comes up. It's not	
12	something that happens in the normal course of	
13	business for CDs for some reason. But I have made	
14	there is a note on the system to send it to me.	
15	So 30 days before maturity, I'll be on the phone	
16	with you guys.	
17	MR. FEKETE: Okay, thank you very much.	
18	Next order of business is U.S.	
19	Army Corps report. Mr. Nguyen.	
20	MR. NGUYEN: Mike Nguyen, Army Corps of	
21	Engineers. Update on the dredging contract. So	
22	dredging was suppose to start June 25th, due to the	
23	weather, the dredging started on July 15th.	
24	Currently we're behind schedule due to the delay in	
25	the stone supply. But the TSCA dredging should be	21

1 completed by August 23rd. So actually the quarry 2 that supplies the stone, the equipment broke down 3 and we had to find another source. By the time we found another source, the equipment came back on. 4 5 It just delayed our TSCA dredging. Nothing to report on the oil 6 7 boom coordination. 8 For the PCA, we are still waiting for our division office to make a decision 9 10 on our alternative resolution for the tipping fee. 11 So I know we sent you a letter on the 24th of June. 12 We are waiting for the Commission to hear back from 13 We are waiting to hear back from them on the 14 Lake George Agreement too. We need both EPA and 15 ECWD signature for both. 16 I guess for the Feddeler, 17 there's no update on that. We sent that letter to 18 the real estate office. 19 The Parkway improvements 20 construction is ongoing and should be complete by 21 end of November, and the entrance road should be 22 complete by September. That's all I have for my 23 report. 24 MR. FEKETE: Very good. Any questions for 25 Mr. Nguyen? 22

1 MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: With respect to 2 Feddeler, why aren't we closing this out? 3 issue has been going on for a very long time. 4 MR. Nguyen: I think right now it's a lower priority. I will ask them again about this. 5 I know due to sort of like our end of fiscal year, 6 7 we have other contracts. Everyone is sort of overloaded with work because we have to spend all 8 9 our money for end of September. So once October 10 comes, I'll see what the status is. I don't want to make this a priority over other contract awards at 11 12 this time. 13 MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Thank you. 14 appreciate it. MR. FEKETE: Next order of business. 15 16 Attorney Ellen Gregory's report. 17 Ellen Gregory, with Ellen MS. GREGORY: 18 Gregory Law. As Fernando mentioned, we have been 19 spending quite a bit of time negotiating the PA, the 20 Statement of Work that goes along with the PA and 21 the Cost Share Agreement, which is between the 22 Waterway District and BP. The Cost Share Agreement is very, very close to being finalized. And once 23 24 that is finalized, agreed by all parties, all three 25 of the documents can be approved and signed at the 23

1	same time.
2	As Mike Nguyen mentioned, the
3	June 24th Position Statement that the Corps
4	submitted is in the dispute resolution process
5	between the Army Corps and the Waterway Management
6	District. On July 26th, Plews Shadley submitted a
7	reply Position Statement to the Army Corps. And as
8	Mike mentioned, we are waiting to hear back from the
9	Army Corps on a number of those dispute issues. So
10	in the meantime we entered into submitted the
11	Tolling Agreement, which we just voted on the
12	Tolling Agreement which will basically allow the
13	Army Corps and us to continue discussions without
14	having to worry about filing a lawsuit to avoid
15	running out of the Statute of Limitation. And
16	that's all I have.
17	MR. FEKETE: Any questions for Miss
18	Gregory? (None) Thank you very much.
19	Any new business to come before
20	the Board?
21	MR. TREVINO: I just wanted to give an
22	update on the Lake Shore Chamber of Commerce is
23	having their 15th annual Business Expo on
24	September 20th. So I will have more information for
25	the Board by the next meeting.

1	MR. FEKETE: Okay. Thank you very much.
2	Other business. I have a question for Mr.
3	Rodriguez. How was your beach clean up?
4	MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: The beach clean up
5	went very well. Surprisingly we had 79 volunteers.
6	We picked up everybody collectively, with the
7	City we picked up 333 pounds off Jeorse Park.
8	All in all, it was a very good turn out and it was
9	good seeing people from the community coming out and
10	volunteering. John Bakota and Henry were there
11	also.
12	MR. BAKOTA: I think Patrick does a good
13	job of organizing it and getting donors to sponsor
14	it, which is a big deal.
