District Board of Directors' Meeting  
09/15/2021

1 MR. FEKETE: All righty. Are you all  
2 set?

3 COURT STENOGRAPHER: Yes, sir.

4 MR. TREVINO: Yep.

5 MR. FEKETE: All right. I would like  
6 to call to order the East Chicago Waterway  
7 Management District Board of Directors'  
8 Meeting. Today's date is September 15,  
9 2021. And the time is 4:59.

10 First order of business is the roll  
11 call.

12 John Bakota?

13 MR. BAKOTA: Here.

14 MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?

15 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Here.

16 MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?

17 (No response.)

18 MR. FEKETE: Ted Zagar?

19 (No response.)

20 MR. FEKETE: Kevin Doyle?

21 (No response.)

22 MR. FEKETE: Ray Lopez?

23 MR. LOPEZ: Here.

24 MR. FEKETE: John Fekete? Here.

25 We have a quorum.

1           And next order of business is the  
2 Executive Director's Report.

3           MR. TREVINO: (Nodding.)

4           MR. FEKETE: Mr. Trevino.

5           MR. TREVINO: Yes. Fernando Trevino  
6 with FMT Consulting.

7           First, I would like to start out  
8 with going over the contents of your board  
9 packet. You have the board minutes -- I'm  
10 sorry, you have the copy of the public  
11 meeting posting for today's meeting.

12           You have the board minutes for  
13 August 18th, 2021.

14           You have a copy of the East Chicago  
15 Waterway Management District Approval Memo  
16 for additional hours for FMT Consulting.  
17 And that memo is dated September 15th, 2021.

18           You have the First Merchants Bank  
19 statements for the month of August of 2021.

20           You have -- And also a copy of the  
21 user fee deposits that were made in the  
22 month  
23 of August.

24           You have a copy of the First  
25 Merchant's Bank CD for account ending in

1 515.

2 You have the BMO Harris Bank ECI  
3 Facility Trust Report dated August 31st,  
4 2021.

5 You have the Army Corps of Engineer  
6 Board Report with a date of September 15th,  
7 2021.

8 You have Attorney Ellen Gregory's  
9 report to the board with a revision date  
10 of September 14th, 2021.

11 Um --

12 (Brief pause had in the proceedings.)

13 You have TetraTech's progress report  
14 for August of 2021.

15 You have a letter from the U.S. EPA  
16 to myself dated August 31st, 2021, regarding  
17 accepted in-kind costs for the Great Lake  
18 Legacy Act Project.

19 You have a copy of the cover letter  
20 when I submitted the first half work in-kind  
21 report summary related to the Great Lake  
22 Legacy Act Project. And that letter is  
23 dated September 21st.

24 You have a letter -- a copy of a  
25 couple emails. The first dated

1 September 14th, 2021, related to a lost  
2 check and a request to issue a stop payment  
3 on it. And so since that check has been  
4 lost that check is on today's claim docket  
5 requesting to be reapproved and reissued.

6 That concludes the items in your  
7 board packet.

8 As far as any update report to the  
9 board, the Army Corps of Engineers and INDOT  
10 reached out to the district requesting our  
11 input regarding Coast Guard's proposal to  
12 change the Indy Boulevard draw bridge  
13 operation from a 24-hour operation attendant  
14 to 12-hour advanced notice attendant.

15 Public feedback on that is due on or before  
16 September 27th of this month, which is this  
17 month. So more on that during the meeting.

18 Regarding finances on today's  
19 agenda, we have a board action item that  
20 is affiliated with the contract that the  
21 District has with FMT Consulting to consider  
22 the option of approving an additional one  
23 hundred hours for the calendar year of 2021.

24 Also, I composed and submitted two  
25 invoices that were sent to BP. One was for

1 the reimbursement for the District's 2020  
2 efforts related to the Section 10 Permit  
3 Agreement and the second invoice is related  
4 to the Great Lake Legacy Act Project.

5       Regarding user fees, our 2021 user  
6 fee collections and deposited to date is  
7 approximately 357,000 or 99.1 percent of  
8 all invoices that were submitted. We  
9 received the \$2,500.00 payment related to  
10 resolving the prior years unpaid user fees  
11 for M & M Management.

12       This resolution includes the 221 user  
13 fee affiliated with that property.

14       We have one outstanding unpaid 2020  
15 user fee. A reminder that the board agreed  
16 to extend the deadline to September 14th  
17 which was yesterday. So I am recommending  
18 that we reach out to Attorney Wieser and  
19 have him pursue legal remedies for the  
20 unpaid balance.

21       Regarding the PCA Amendment, just  
22 to -- kind of a reminder that we have --  
23 conceptually have a final document between  
24 the District and the Army Corps. So the PCA  
25 Amendment has been approved by the Corps'



1 headquarters and now it's being run past the  
2 Army Corps secretary. So once that gets --  
3 Once we hear back that that has been  
4 approved or -- or -- hopefully approved,  
5 then we will ask the Board to approve that  
6 amendment and have it signed and send  
7 it to the Corps for counter signature. I  
8 know that we have been saying this for the  
9 last two or three months, but we are hoping  
10 to have that document ready for the next  
11 board meeting which is -- and we had a  
12 meeting to discuss an update on that earlier  
13 today so that -- they didn't report any  
14 concerns with the approval.

15       Regarding the Great Lakes Legacy Act  
16 Project, you might recall that the project  
17 agreement fourth modification was approved  
18 by the Board and BP and we were waiting for  
19 EPA approval. EPA has now approved that  
20 fourth amendment and the project team  
21 received a signed copy from EPA on  
22 August 19th and have a fully executed  
23 project agreement fourth modification and  
24 that was also forwarded to the Board on  
25 August 20th.

1 South Tank Farm Sheet Pile Wall  
2 Project, the ninety percent basis of design  
3 report is ongoing.

4 The Lake George Canal East section, a  
5 reminder that Phase I dredging was completed  
6 in 2020. Phase II dredging isn't scheduled  
7 to recommence until after the South Tank  
8 Farm Sheet Pile Wall Project is completed  
9 which is scheduled to be done at the end of  
10 2023 or after.

11 Lake George Canal Middle Cap Project.  
12 The Army Corps has received the proposals  
13 for this project and they are going through  
14 their review process.

15 BP's pipeline removal project. BP's  
16 -- This project is now completed. They  
17 removed the approximately 22,366 linear  
18 feet of piping from the west tank farm  
19 and around 200 linear feet from the south  
20 tank farm. All piping and collected liquids  
21 affiliated with the removal have been  
22 transported and disposed of off site.  
23 Construction crew demobilization should be  
24 done by this week.

25 The Grand Cal' River Junction Reaches

1 Remedial Design. TetraTech design work is  
2 ongoing. The project team continues to  
3 have periodic meetings advancing the design  
4 work.

5 Lake George Canal West Project. BP  
6 and EPA continue to work on finalizing the  
7 project agreement between the two parties,  
8 which will address the Lake George Canal  
9 West section of the waterway.

10 The Great Lakes Legacy Act work  
11 in-kind report. I have completed the 2021  
12 semiannual work in-kind report which was  
13 sent to EPA on September 1st. The board  
14 was copied on my email transmittal when it  
15 was sent to EPA and a copy of the letter --  
16 of the cover letter is in your board packet.

17 The Canal Street Bridge Project is --  
18 the design of the two dolphins is ongoing.  
19 AECOM is working through some permitting  
20 efforts with the appropriate agencies.

21 The BP term sheet agreement for the  
22 parcels BP is interested in acquiring. We  
23 continue to have periodic meetings with BP  
24 to advance this effort. You might recall  
25 that the district contracted with two

1 appraisers to develop appraisal reports  
2 for these properties. We have received a  
3 draft of the two reports and we are going  
4 through our review process.

5 A copy of the Army Corps board report  
6 is in your packet and Attorney Ellen Gregory  
7 will be giving various updates on legal  
8 matters.

9 And that concluded my report.

10 MR. FEKETE: Any questions for  
11 Mr. Trevino?

12 (No response.)

13 COURT STENOGRAPHER: Did we lose  
14 Ms. Gregory --

15 (Brief off-the-record discussion had  
16 in the proceedings.)

17 MS. GREGORY: Yeah. I am still here.  
18 (Indicating)

19 MR. FEKETE: Okay.

20 MR. LOPEZ: Ray, question?

21 MR. TREVINO: Yes.

22 MR. LOPEZ: The last report over here  
23 is April 27th, 2021, for the cross share  
24 dispute. Where is it at now? Remember,  
25 they were supposed to owe us money?

1 MR. TREVINO: Okay. I am not sure  
2 what you are referring to. Can I see  
3 please?

4 (Brief pause had in the proceedings.)

5 (Mr. Trevino reading said document.)

6 MR. TREVINO: Yes, this is affiliated  
7 with the modifying the project cooperation  
8 agreement with the Corps. So once we have  
9 that finalized we will be presenting that  
10 to the board for approval.

11 MR. LOPEZ: This is dated in April, so  
12 it --

13 MR. TREVINO: Yeah.

14 MR. LOPEZ: -- it's all going to be  
15 one package?

16 MR. TREVINO: Yes, unfortunately,  
17 that's how long it takes to --

18 MR. FEKETE: To get through the  
19 Corps --

20 MR. TREVINO: -- to get through the  
21 Corps --

22 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yeah.

23 MR. TREVINO: That's probably why.

24 MR. BAKOTA: That's why we haven't  
25 got our checks.

1 MR. FEKETE: I keep checking the  
2 mailbox.

3 MR. LOPEZ: And it's still ongoing  
4 with the canal bridge, right?

5 MR. TREVINO: Uh-huh. Yep.

6 MR. LOPEZ: Okay.

7 MR. TREVINO: Yes.

8 MR. LOPEZ: Thank you.

9 MR. FEKETE: Any other questions?

10 Thank you, Mr. Trevino.

11 The next order of business is the  
12 approval consideration of a board meeting  
13 notes for August 18th. Since all board  
14 members are present we will take a voice  
15 vote.

16 All in favor signify by saying, "Aye".

17 ALL: Aye.

18 MR. FEKETE: Any opposition?

19 Hearing none, that motion is approved.

20 Accounting consultant report.

21 Mr. Trevino you are going to report on  
22 behalf of Mr. Anderson.

23 MR. TREVINO: That is correct. So I  
24 provided a copy of -- I also emailed it  
25 earlier today, but I also provided a hard

1 copy of Mr. Anderson's report dated August  
2 31st. Page two is a summary of receipts  
3 through August 31st and a summary of  
4 disbursements.

5 It also shows an increase in cash and  
6 a cash balance at the beginning of the year  
7 and a cash balance as of August 31st. And  
8 the cash balance as of August 31st is  
9 approximately 4.2 million and that's --  
10 that covers the -- our cash that's within  
11 the First Merchants Bank accounts.

12 MR. FEKETE: Okay.

13 MR. TREVINO: And if you look at the  
14 bottom of that report it also shows --  
15 breaks it down between the three accounts  
16 that we have with First Merchants. The  
17 operating account, which basically is used  
18 to manage our annual budget, and then the  
19 account that we call the user fee account  
20 where we, you know, deposit all the user  
21 fee payments. And then the third is the  
22 certificate of deposit that we have with  
23 First Merchants.

24 Page three is a summary of the  
25 operating account and it shows the cash

1 disbursements by month and as well at --  
2 for the operating account and for the user  
3 fee account. And it also has details  
4 related to the certificate of deposit.

5 And the last sheet, page four, is  
6 our Budget Management Spreadsheet. So, you  
7 know, it shows an itemized list of all of  
8 our budget line items for the year. And it  
9 shows the budget amount for 2021. And then  
10 the last column on the right shows the  
11 unused budget so that you can see all of our  
12 unused budget is in the positive. And then  
13 the second to the last column is a summary  
14 of our claim docket that's -- that you have  
15 in front of you that's on the docket -- on  
16 the agenda for approval consideration.

17 And that summarizes Mr. Anderson's  
18 report.

19 MR. FEKETE: Okay. Any questions?

20 MR. LOPEZ: None.

21 MR. FEKETE: Hearing none.

22 Thank you very much. Thank  
23 Mr. Anderson for his preparation.

24 MR. TREVINO: (Nodding.)

25 MR. FEKETE: And the next order of

2 for the accounts payable voucher register  
3 dated today's date September 15th, 2021.

4 I will entertain a motion to approve.

5 MR. BAKOTA: Motion to approve.

6 MR. FEKETE: Do I have a second?

7 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Second.

8 MR. FEKETE: We have a motion and a  
9 second and I have a roll call vote.

10 John Bakota?

11 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

12 MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?

13 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

14 MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?

15 (No response.)

16 MR. FEKETE: Ted Zagar?

17 (No response.)

13 Okay. I have a roll call vote.

14 John Bakota?

4 Army Corps Report.

5 Mr. Trevino, do you want to just  
6 quickly summarize it?

7 MR. TREVINO: Yeah. Is anyone on for  
8 the Corps?

9 (Brief pause had in the proceedings.)

10 (No response.)

11 MR. TREVINO: Okay. So, yeah, I  
12 will give a quick summary of the report  
13 that was submitted to us.

14 Regarding the CDR construction.  
15 Contractor will demobilize barges from  
16 the --

17 COURT STENOGRAPHER: I'm sorry, the  
18 contractor will --

19 MR. TREVINO: -- will demobilize  
20 barges from the site at the end of  
21 September. Water treatment was completed  
22 in August and the contractor has demobilized  
23 the water treatment plant.

24 Regarding the Phase II Dike Raise  
25 project. The construction --

1 MR. FEKETE: Dye grade?

2 MR. TREVINO: Phase II Dike Raise  
3 project. The construction is ongoing.

4 Regarding CDF documentation. Oil  
5 boom coordination, nothing significant to  
6 report.

7 Regarding the PTA revisions the  
8 Corps and the District reached an agreement.  
9 Army Corps' Headquarters proposed changes  
10 to the PCA amendment received updated  
11 self-certification of the sponsor's  
12 financial capability. Certificate of  
13 authority and certificate regarding  
14 lobbying is currently in the process of  
15 updating the PCA amendment package.

16 Regarding the federal parcel  
17 resolution. The Corps real estate staff  
18 requested additional information for the  
19 LERR credit, that's L-E-R-R, and received  
20 it on July 20th of last year. Received an  
21 update letter on May 18th to request the  
22 LERR credit in the amount of \$95,261.82.

23 And the parkway improvement project  
24 was completed last year.

25 And that concludes the Army Corps

1 report that was in your packet.

2 MR. FEKETE: Okay. Thank you,  
3 Mr. Trevino. And thank Mr. Wynn for  
4 preparing it for us.

5 MR. TREVINO: Sure.

6 MR. FEKETE: The next order of  
7 business is the Attorney Ellen Gregory  
8 Report. Ms. Gregory.

9 MS. GREGORY: Yes, Ellen Gregory  
10 with Ellen Gregory.

11 A couple of these items have been  
12 mentioned already a couple times by  
13 Fernando, but I will go through them again  
14 anyway.

15 MR. FEKETE: Okay.

16 MS. GREGORY: The PCA amendment. We  
17 are waiting for the secretary of the Army  
18 to approve. Once we receive that the  
19 document will be presented to the board  
20 for approval and signature. And then the  
21 Army Corps will be the final signature as  
22 has been the procedure.

23 Property transfer. We have periodic  
24 calls with BP and Jim Wieser has taken the  
25 lead on the real estate legal aspects of

1 the fourth modification of PCA. Has  
2 been signed by EPA.

3 The Canal Street Bridge, as Fernando  
4 mentioned the final design memo for the  
5 dolphins is complete and we are working  
6 through printing issues.

7 The Indianapolis Boulevard Drawbridge.  
8 There was a federal register notice on -- on  
9 -- published on July 28th. Public comments  
10 are due by September 27th. I will be  
11 coordinating with Fernando on a response  
12 on behalf of the District. Um -- And just  
13 today Fernando received a public records  
14 request from a company called AD -- I'm  
15 sorry, IDAR Group, they have requested  
16 information regarding the District employees  
17 in connection with what they are terming a  
18 research and analysis into the public sector  
19 titles and contact insights.

20 COURT STENOGRAPHER: I'm sorry, and  
21 contacting sites?

22 MS. GREGORY: And contact insights,  
23 i-n-s-i-g-h-t-s.

24 COURT STENOGRAPHER: Thank you.

25 THE WITNESS: I will be coordinating

1 with Fernando to respond to that since we  
2 don't have any employees it's like the  
3 response will just be that we don't have  
4 any employees.

5 MR. LOPEZ: Good.

6 MS. GREGORY: And that's all that I  
7 have.

8 MR. LOPEZ: Wow. That was great.

9 MR. FEKETE: Okay. Any questions  
10 for Ms. Gregory.

11 (No response.)

12 MR. FEKETE: Thank you, Ellen.

13 MS. GREGORY: (Nodding.)

14 MR. FEKETE: We didn't have on the  
15 agenda the BMO Harris Report. Did you want  
16 to just touch on that?

17 MR. TREVINO: Yeah, I can -- Let's  
18 see.

19 (Brief pause had in the proceedings.)

20 MR. TREVINO: Okay. So you have a  
21 copy of your BMO Trust Report as of August  
22 31st. We will just touch on a couple  
23 highlights of the report. So the -- As of  
24 the end of the month the prime money market  
25 has approximately 3.2 million, the 13th

1 month CD has 1.2 million, which expires on  
2 January 31st of the next year. And the  
3 total trust balance is approximately  
4 4.4 million.

5 MR. FEKETE: Okay. So there is no  
6 action required at this moment?

7 MR. TREVINO: No, not of the BMO.

8 MR. FEKETE: Okay. Probably in  
9 December we will have the finance committee  
10 meeting on it?

11 MR. TREVINO: Right. You might  
12 recall that the reason that there is a  
13 significant amount of money in the money  
14 market is because the -- the available  
15 interest rate options were so low that  
16 they were pretty close to leave it in  
17 the money market.

18 MR. FEKETE: Right.

19 THE WITNESS: And we are going to see  
20 if -- um -- if -- if a better opportunity  
21 comes up, you know, in the next few weeks.

22 MR. LOPEZ: Yeah.

23 MR. FEKETE: Right.

24 MR. TREVINO: And then we will be able  
25 to hopefully get a better rate.
