2 MS. GREGORY: Okay. So on Zoom, we have John
3 Fekete. We have myself, Ellen Gregory. We have
4 Vanessa Vargas, Vaughn Coolman and Carol Neeson.

5 MR. ROBINSON: I would like to call to order
6 the East Chicago Waterway Management District Board of
7 Directors Special Public Board Meeting. Today's date
8 is April 7, 2026. First call to order roll call.

9 MR. ROBINSON: John Fekete?

10 MR. FEKETE: Here.

11 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

12 MR. BAKOTA: Here.

13 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

14 MR. LOPEZ: Here.

15 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

16 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Here.

17 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson. I am here.

18 Next we have the Executive Director's Report.

19 MR. TREVINO: Yes. Fernando Trevino with FMT
20 Consulting. Just for the record, today's Special Board
21 meeting was scheduled because our regular board meeting
22 in March we didn't have a quorum, so we weren't able to
23 approve the action items. So the Board packet that I
24 sent out yesterday is pretty much the same as the one
25 that was sent out for the March Board meeting, except

1 for a couple of changes. The agenda is slightly
2 changed. The posting for today's meeting is of course
3 for today's meeting, April 7th. And then the claim
4 docket had some modifications. Other than that, the
5 contents are the same. I would like to go over the
6 contents really quick. And your Board packet includes
7 today's agenda, the public meeting posting for today's
8 meeting, the Board minutes for February 19, 2026. The
9 general liability property insurance proposal renewal
10 proposed 2026 budget amendment dated March 19, 2026.

11 Tetra Tech's monthly Progress Report Invoice Budget
12 summary for the month of February dated March 4, 2026.

13 You have a copy of Tetra Tech Change Order
14 Number 4 dated March 16, 2026. You have the
15 CliftonLarsonAllen Financial Report dated February 28,
16 2026 for the month of February.

17 You have the Claim Docket dated April 7, 2026
18 with copies of purchase orders and the Check Register.

19 You have a copy of the Department of Army
20 Right of Entry for the Construction Agreement.

21 You also have a copy of the BMO Trust Report
22 dated February 28, 2026.

23 You have a copy of the BMO Non-Trust Report
24 summarizing our CDs.

25 Copy of First Merchants bank statements for

1 the month of February 2026 for accounts ending in 616
2 and 608 and the deposits made in February for the
3 account ending in 616.

4 You have the Army Corps Report to the Board
5 dated March 19, 2026.

6 You have Attorney Ellen Gregory's Report with
7 the revision date of March 17, 2026.

8 A copy of Gateway Annual Financial Report for
9 2025.

10 You have the Waterway Management District's
11 2025 Great Lakes Legacy Act Project Year End Work in
12 Kind report summary dated March 18, 2026.

13 You have a copy of the flyer from the City of
14 East Chicago advertising their Team up and clean up
15 Community date for May 15, 2026. And you have a flyer
16 from the Lakeshore Chamber of Commerce regarding their
17 annual awards dinner for Thursday, March 26, 2026,
18 which of course was expired.

19 So that's the summary of the items that are
20 in your Board packet.

21 Go over a couple things. We have the two
22 routine monthly action items on today's agenda, the
23 Board minutes for February 19th and the monthly claim
24 docket with today's date. And then you have four
25 additional action items. One is for the approval to

1 renew the liability insurance.

2 Regarding the District finances this month,
3 we have a 2026 budget amendment and a Tetra Tech Change
4 Order Number 4 related to the same budget amendment and
5 the change orders related to the Grand Cal River
6 Junction Reaches project.

7 Regarding User Fees, the Board may recall
8 that we had one unpaid User Fee which triggered us to
9 ask Attorney Weiser to get involved in our collection
10 process. Since then, that last unpaid User Fee has
11 been paid. So now we're at 100% collection for 2025
12 User Fees.

13 Regarding the Great Lakes Legacy Act project,
14 the design for the South Tank Farm Barrier Wall
15 Groundwater Management System is ongoing. ARBP has
16 reported that the design is at 60%.

17 Regarding the Lake George Canal East, the
18 Corps is managing that project on EPA's behalf. The
19 Corps' work on the dredging design is ongoing. Phase
20 II of the Lake George Canal East dredging schedule may
21 be pushed into 2026. The project is currently planning
22 to use the local CDF to dispose materials dredged from
23 the project. There is a -- in your packet and on the
24 agenda is approval for a right of entry for the CDF
25 affiliated with the project.

1 The Cleveland Cliff SEP dredging is
2 forecasted to be done in 2027 and may even be delayed
3 into 2028.

4 Regarding the Lake George Canal Middle Cap
5 project, the Army Corps of Engineers is managing that
6 section of the project as well.

7 The CAP's construction has been completed.
8 However, ECO construction activities and adaptive
9 management plan activities are ongoing.

10 Regarding the Lake George Canal West
11 Remediation Project, that work is ongoing and that's
12 between BP and EPA. Based on the latest site
13 characterization data, BP recommended no further action
14 is necessary. The Corps and EPA continued to assess
15 BP's no further action recommendation, which is
16 currently expected to include additional sampling in
17 that effort.

18 Regarding the Grand Cal River Junction
19 Reaches Project, the Tetra Tech remedial design work is
20 ongoing. Tetra Tech recently transmitted the 95%
21 design for project team review. So that that process
22 is ongoing. Some of the other activities include
23 junction marsh coordination, coordination with the
24 former city dump site, the Marquette Trail Project,
25 community engagement, property access coordination,

1 including agreements and various permits necessary for
2 construction, including the TASCA permit and of course
3 remedial design completion. Carol Neeson is also in
4 attendance and will provide additional updates.

5 As part of the Grand Cal River remediation
6 project, there is a proposed Change Order Number 4 for
7 Tetra Tech and that Change Order will require a budget
8 amendment. So both of those items are on today's
9 agenda and Carol can speak to those during her update
10 and answer any questions you might have.

11 Regarding the Great Lakes Legacy Act Work In
12 Kind Reporting, I submitted the District's 2025
13 year-end Work In Kind Report a couple weeks ago. A
14 copy of that report, minus the attachments, is included
15 in your Board packet. I continue to work on the City
16 CSO Work in Kind Report. EPA's review continues on our
17 2024 and prior year Work In Kind reports. A couple
18 months ago I submitted the Work In Kind report for the
19 City dump project. So we have received conditional
20 approval from EPA on that submittal.

21 Regarding the schedule for the Grand Cal
22 River Junction Reaches, we're forecasting to complete
23 the remedial design and contractor procurement
24 activities in the first three quarters of this year
25 with mobilization in the fourth quarter of this year.

1 The report on the Corps, the Army Corps
2 Report is in your Board packet. Project Manager Vaughn
3 Coolman will be providing update report to the Board.
4 Attorney Ellen Gregory will give an update on various
5 legal matters. And we did get a report that there was
6 an incident near the Canal Street Bridge where either
7 the tugboat or a barge struck the Canadian National
8 Bridge in some manner. We don't have a lot of details
9 on it. We have heard that the Coast Guard is doing an
10 investigation. When Vaughn Coolman gives us a report,
11 we can ask him if he has any additional details. But
12 as of yesterday, him and I had a conversation and so he
13 was still waiting to hear from the Coast Guard. So
14 that's an update. That's my update to the Board. Any
15 questions or comments?

16 MR. ROBINSON: Next we have the approval
17 consideration for the February 19, 2025 Board meetings.
18 Is there a motion?

19 MR. BAKOTA: Motion to Approve?

20 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Second.

21 MR. ROBINSON: Okay. So a roll call vote,
22 John Feckete?

23 MR. FEKETE: Yes.

24 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

25 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

1 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

2 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

3 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

4 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

5 MR. ROBINSON: Jaylan Robinson. I vote yes.

6 Next we have the approval consideration for
7 the renewal of the property and general liability
8 insurance. Is there a motion?

9 MR. LOPEZ: Motion to Approve.

10 MR. BAKOTA: Second.

11 MR. ROBINSON: All right. It's been motioned
12 and properly seconded. Roll call vote.

13 MR. ROBINSON: John Fekete?

14 MR. FEKETE: Yes.

15 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

16 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

17 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

18 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

19 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

20 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

21 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson. I vote yes.

22 Next, we have the Great Lakes Legacy Act and
23 the Grand Cal River Junction Reaches Project update.

24 MR. TREVINO: Yes. During my report,
25 Mr. President and fellow Board members, I gave a

1 general summary update on the Grand Canal River
2 Junction Reaches. I mentioned that there's -- as part
3 of our efforts, it will require a Change Order Number 4
4 from Tetra Tech and budget amendment affiliated with
5 that Change Order. I'd like to -- Carol Neeson is in
6 attendance. I'd like to turn it over to her for she
7 can provide her update as well as a summary of the
8 Change Order. Carol?

9 MS. NEESON: Yeah. Hi, everyone. Yes, Tetra
10 Tech completed the 95% design in February, and there
11 were a significant number of comments from EPA on the
12 90% design that required additional modeling to amend
13 the design. We needed to run more geotechnical models
14 per the EPA comments. We also had to update the
15 surface water modeling and then had to regenerate some
16 of the calculations for the armor design. So there was
17 a bit of additional work that we needed to do to
18 address all of EPA's comments in order to produce the
19 95% design.

20 At this point, we have completed one of the
21 permit applications and we're working on the rest of
22 them. They'll be completed very soon. We are also
23 talking about a lot of different property access
24 points. So that will require some amendments to the
25 specifications and the design to accommodate some of

1 the real estate issues for the area.

2 GLNPO also requested that Tetra Tech produce
3 a Gantt schedule. So we prepared that and submitted
4 it. And we also attended meetings with IDEM and the
5 coordination on the Marquette Trail. Any questions?

6 MR. ROBINSON: Nope.

7 MR. LOPEZ: Thank you.

8 MS. NEESON: Thank you.

9 MR. ROBINSON: All right. Next we have
10 approval consideration for the 2026 budget amendment.
11 Is there a motion?

12 MR. RODRIGUEZ: I make a Motion to Approve?

13 MR. LOPEZ: Second.

14 MR. ROBINSON: All right. There's been a
15 motion and a second. Roll call vote. John Feckete?

16 MR. FEKETE: Yes.

17 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

18 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

19 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

20 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

21 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

22 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

23 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson. I vote yes.

24 Next we have the approval consideration for
25 the Tetra Tech Change Order Number 4. Is there a

1 motion?

2 MR. RODRIGUEZ: I make a Motion to Approve?

3 MR. BAKOTA: Second.

4 MR. ROBINSON: All right. There's been a
5 motion and a second. We got a roll call vote. John
6 Fekete?

7 MR. FEKETE: Yes.

8 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

9 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

10 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

11 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

12 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

13 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

14 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson. I vote yes.
15 Next we have our Accounting Consulting Report.

16 MR. TREVINO: Vanessa.

17 MS. VARGAS: Hi, everyone. Vanessa Vargas
18 with CLA. Can you hear me okay?

19 MR. TREVINO: Yes.

20 MS. VARGAS: Okay. All right. In front of
21 you, you have the financial statements on a cash basis
22 dated February 28, 2026. If you turn to Page 2, we
23 will begin with the Statement of Cash Receipts and Cash
24 Disbursements for the two months ended February 28,
25 2026. You've earned interest income in the amount of

1 \$137,628.71. You've collected User Fees in the amount
2 of \$126,396.37, as well as had a trust transfer in the
3 amount of \$38,490.77, which brings your total receipts
4 to \$302,515.85.

5 Your total Cash Disbursements have been
6 \$145,976.21. This brings you to an increase in cash in
7 the amount of \$156,539.64.

8 You began the year with a cash balance on
9 January 1, 2026 in the amount of \$14,951,631.66. Your
10 cash balance as of February 28, 2026 is \$15,108,171.30.

11 If you turn to Page 3, we will continue with
12 the schedule of cash account activity for the two
13 months ended February 28, 2026. Your Operating Account
14 began the year with a cash balance on January 1st in
15 the amount of \$1,308,102.21. You've earned interest in
16 the amount of \$5,710.06. Had cash disbursements in the
17 amount of \$145,976.21, as well as a trust transfer in
18 the amount of \$38,490.77 and a budget transfer in the
19 amount of \$277,191.52, which brings your operating cash
20 balance as of February 28th to \$1,483,518.35.

21 Your User Fee account began the year with a
22 cash balance on January 1st in the amount of
23 \$1,900,236.71. You've earned interest in the amount of
24 \$8,348.21. You've collected User Fees in the amount of
25 \$126,396.37 and had a budget transfer in the amount of

1 \$277,191.52, which brings your User Fee account balance
2 as of February 28th to \$1,757,789.77.

3 You began the year with a CD balance on
4 January 1st in the number of \$11,743,292.74. You've
5 earned interest in the amount of \$123,570.44, which
6 brings your CD balance as of February 28th to
7 \$11,866,863.18.

8 If you turn to Page 4, we will continue with
9 the schedule of 2026 available budget as of March 19th,
10 2026. Your 2026 budget appropriation totaled
11 \$1,553,089. Adding back in accounts payable dated
12 12/31/2025 in the amount of \$70,695.50. Brings your
13 2026 total appropriation to \$1,623,784.50. Cash
14 Disbursements for the two months ended February 2026
15 totals \$145,976.21. You have a claim docket which was
16 originally dated March 19, 2026 in the amount of
17 \$70,559.79, which brings your unused budget for 2026 to
18 \$1,407,248.50. Are there any questions on the
19 financials?

20 MR. LOPEZ: Thank you.

21 MS. VARGAS: You're welcome. Just to quickly
22 mention the claim docket that is on these financial
23 statements still reflects the original date. The claim
24 docket in the front of you, the signature page was
25 updated for today's date. The total amount of

1 \$70,559.79 did not change. Neither did the budget line
2 items. The only change there was the insurance vendor.
3 But if you have any questions, we can also discuss
4 that. You will notice that the PO for Rothschild
5 Agency is still included in the docket. It's just the
6 way that Keystone voids those POs. But as of April 2nd
7 of last week that PO was actually voided and you should
8 also be seeing the copy of the voided check for the
9 Rothschild Agency.

10 MR. TREVINO: Yeah. And just a little bit
11 more background on that. So the Rothschild insurance
12 invoice was originally going to be paid directly to
13 Rothschild, but that insurance was paid by Attorney
14 Ellen Gregory so we would not lose our -- so the
15 insurance wouldn't be terminated. So the two changes
16 that Vanessa explained includes basically deleting the
17 Rothschild invoice and then including reimbursement to
18 Attorney Ellen Gregory for that payment. Is that
19 accurate, Vanessa?

20 MS. VARGAS: Yes. Correct. And then you'll
21 see that in the AP, the -- voucher, you will see that
22 Ellen has an additional reimbursement and the
23 Rothschild Agency is no longer included on there..

24 MR. ROBINSON: All right. Next we have --

25 MR. TREVINO: We've got to make a Motion to

1 Approve the claim docket.

2 MR. ROBINSON: Next we have the approval
3 consideration for the accounts payable voucher register
4 dated April 7, 2026. Is there a Motion?

5 MR. LOPEZ: Motion to Accept?

6 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Second.

7 MR. ROBINSON: All right. There's been a
8 motion and a second. Roll call vote. John Fekete?

9 MR. FEKETE: Yes.

10 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

11 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

12 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

13 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

14 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

15 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

16 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson. I vote yes.

17 Next we have the approval consideration for
18 the Army Corps CDF Right of Way Entry Agreement. Is
19 there a motion?

20 MR. RODRIGUEZ: I make a Motion to Approve?

21 MR. LOPEZ: Second.

22 MR. ROBINSON: Right. There's been a motion
23 and second. Roll call vote. John Fekete?

24 MR. FEKETE: I vote yes.

25 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

1 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

2 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

3 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

4 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

5 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

6 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson? I vote yes.

7 Next we have the BMO Trust and non-Trust
8 Reports.

9 MR. TREVINO: Yes. I'm recommending that we
10 forego that. At the last board meeting, Mr. Santori
11 gave a summary report on the BMO reports on his
12 financial reports. He will provide an additional
13 update at our meeting next week, at our regular Board
14 meeting, which will be the reports for the month ending
15 in March of 2026.

16 MR. ROBINSON: Next we have the U. S. Army
17 Corps of Engineering Board Report.

18 MR. TREVINO: Mr. Coolman? Vaughn, are you
19 on?

20 MR. COOLMAN: Yeah. I was just trying to
21 find the unmute.

22 MR. TREVINO: Looks like you found it.

23 MR. COOLMAN: Nice to see everybody tonight.
24 The water, wastewater treatment plant at the CDF has
25 been undergoing startup testing. And so they should be

1 starting with, if all goes well with that, knock on
2 wood. Then we will start water treatment probably
3 right around the end of this month, beginning of May.
4 Dyke raise is still undergoing through some closeout
5 documents with the contractors. And we did award the
6 dredging contract for Indiana Harbor and Canal on March
7 19th. So just a couple weeks ago. That was to ROEN
8 salvage. They're the same contractor that did the last
9 maintenance dredging. So we have some high confidence
10 in their capabilities. And I think that's about it.

11 We're still doing the oil boom coordination
12 when necessary and maintaining the parkway as well.
13 And like Fernando said, we are waiting to see if we
14 hear anything from the Coast Guard, but with the
15 partial government shutdown still going on, they are
16 one of the agencies that is affected by that. But
17 we're not sure exactly. Sometimes we're able to get in
18 touch with some of them. Sometimes we're not. Right
19 now, we haven't been able to get in touch with some of
20 our contacts over there. The newspaper article
21 there -- was that the Northwest Indiana Times, I
22 believe, Fernando?

23 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

24 MR. COOLMAN: Something like that. It said
25 "Coast Guard spokesman" said something, but I'm not

1 sure. They didn't give a name. So they have to know
2 who that is. Otherwise, we might be able to reach out
3 to that person of the Coast Guard to try to get a
4 little bit more information. But that is on our radar.
5 And if we have updates, I'll coordinate those with
6 Fernando so that everybody knows what's going on. But
7 if that is the Canadian National Rail Bridge, that's
8 also the area where they had the sinkhole, if I'm not
9 mistaken. So that might add to the planning for that
10 project that Canadian National was undergoing for that
11 repair. Hopefully it didn't affect anything that would
12 negatively affect that project. Any questions?

13 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yeah. Well, it just sounds
14 like the details affiliated with the barge or the
15 tugboat striking, whatever it struck, the details are
16 still vague. And I guess those are the details that
17 you're pursuing with the Coast Guard, correct?

18 MR. COOLMAN: Yeah. I mean, who's tugboat or
19 was it a tugboat, was it a barge, whose was it?

20 MR. TREVINO: Right.

21 MR. COOLMAN: What the damage was. Did
22 anything fall off so that we might be dealing with
23 another obstruction like we were the last time?
24 Hopefully not, but we'll -- as soon as we find anything
25 out, we'll keep you updated.

1 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yeah. Thanks, Vaughn.

2 MR. ROBINSON: Thank you.

3 MR. ROBINSON: Al right. Next we have
4 Attorney Ellen Gregory Report.

5 MS. GREGORY: Yes, Ellen Gregory with Ellen
6 Gregory Law. Fernando and I continue to work on
7 coordinating with Tetra Tech on the Grand Cal River
8 Junction Reaches project, including negotiating access
9 agreements.

10 Fernando and I are also looking into
11 exploring risk management options related to the
12 District's involvement in the permitting and access
13 agreements.

14 I'm also working on preparing a first draft
15 of a MOU with the City regarding the Brownfield's
16 Assessment grant through the EPA. On the insurance
17 renewal, just to kind of clarify what Fernando had
18 already mentioned, the Rothschild Agency was going to
19 require that payment be made before this Special Board
20 Meeting was able to take place. So I agreed to invoice
21 that through my invoicing process.

22 And then finally Fernando had mentioned we
23 had also negotiated the right of entry with the Army
24 Corps of Engineers or access to the CDF property in
25 relation to the dredging project. That's all I have

1 for today. Any questions?

2 MR. LOPEZ: Thank you.

3 MS. GREGORY: You're welcome.

4 MR. ROBINSON: Next, do we have any other
5 business, new business or announcements? Any public
6 comment?

7 Next public board meeting will be April 16,
8 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Is there a Motion to Adjourn.

9 MR. BAKOTA: Motion to adjourn?

10 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Second.

11 MR. ROBINSON: Motion and second. Roll call
12 vote. John Fekete?

13 MR. FEKETE: I vote yes.

14 MR. ROBINSON: John Bakota?

15 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

16 MR. ROBINSON: Ray Lopez?

17 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

18 MR. ROBINSON: Henry Rodriguez?

19 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

20 MR. ROBINSON: Jalan Robinson. I vote yes.

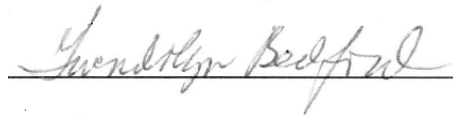
