

## Diapering Procedure for Children Three (3) Years of Age and Older

<p><b><u>REQUIRED</u></b></p> <p>(A) Must <i>not</i> use two's, toddlers, or infant's diaper changing table or their room/area to change diapers.</p> <p>(B) Diapering must take place within 10 feet of a hand washing sink.</p> <p>(C) Must use a designated, sanitizable table or cot which is not used for any other purpose. The designated cot must be stored away from children when not in use.</p> <p>(D) The cot and table must be sanitized with a 1 tablespoon of bleach solution to 1 quart of water after each use.</p> <p>(E) Soiled/wet diapers must be placed in a covered container and container must be emptied daily.</p> <p>(F) Caregivers must wash hands using the proper procedure before and after each diaper change.</p> <p>(G) Children must wash hands using the proper procedure after each diaper change.</p> <p><b><u>RECOMMENDED</u></b></p> <p>(A) Child may stand while diaper is being changed if it effectively accommodates the child and caregiver.</p> <p>(B) Because this child is older, it is recommended that the diapering process be done in a private area and away from other children.</p>	<p><b><u>REQUIRED</u></b></p> <p>(A) Child must be placed on a sturdy, washable and sanitizable surface</p> <p>(B) Waterproof paper must be placed between the surface and the child.
