The Bureau of Disabilities Services announced on February 12, 2026, an opportunity for public comment for upcoming amendments to the Community Integration and Habilitation waiver, Family Supports waiver, Health and Wellness waiver, Traumatic Brain Injury, and 1915 b(4) waivers.

With a projected effective date of August 1, 2026, the public comment period will be opened on February 11, 2026, and has been extended through March 18, 2026.
