







## Indicator 3A: Child Outcomes - Positive Social Emotional Skills






















### Indicator 5: Child Find - % of Children **Birth to Age 1 with IFSPs**






## Indicator 6: Child Find - % of Children Birth to Age 3 with IFSPs








#### **Indicator 7: Timeliness of IFSP** Initial evaluation, assessment, and IFSP within 45 days












