

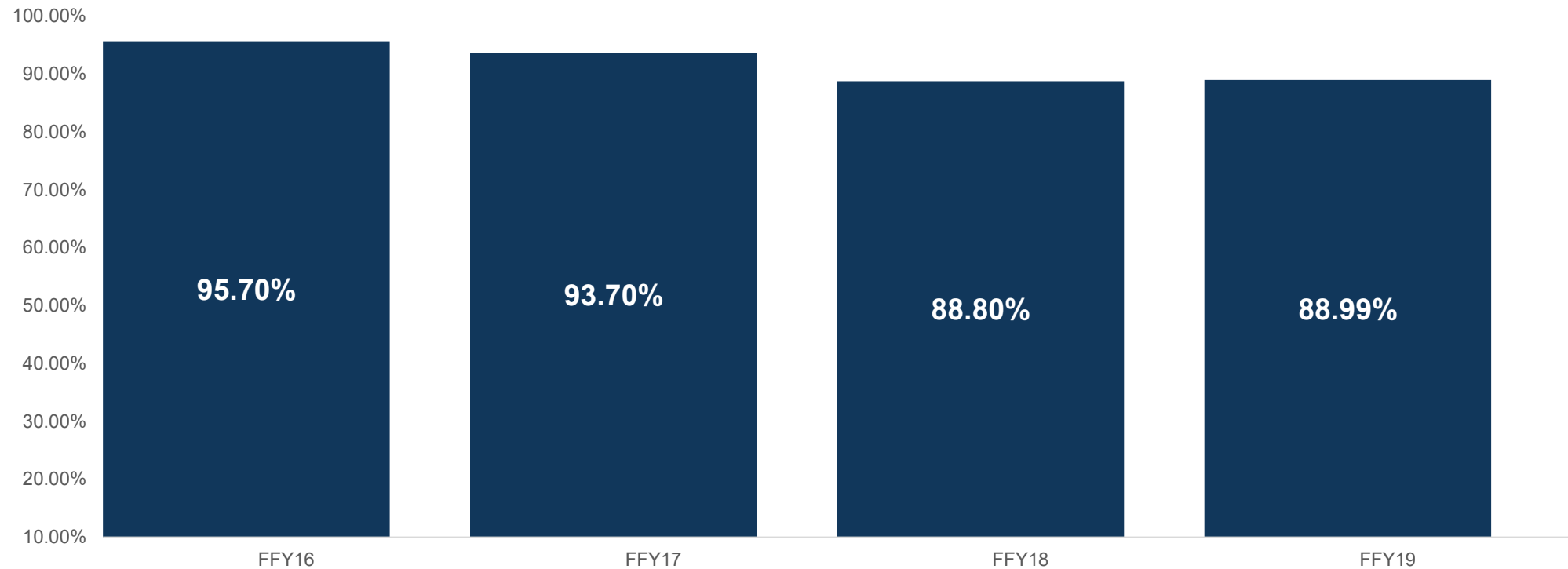

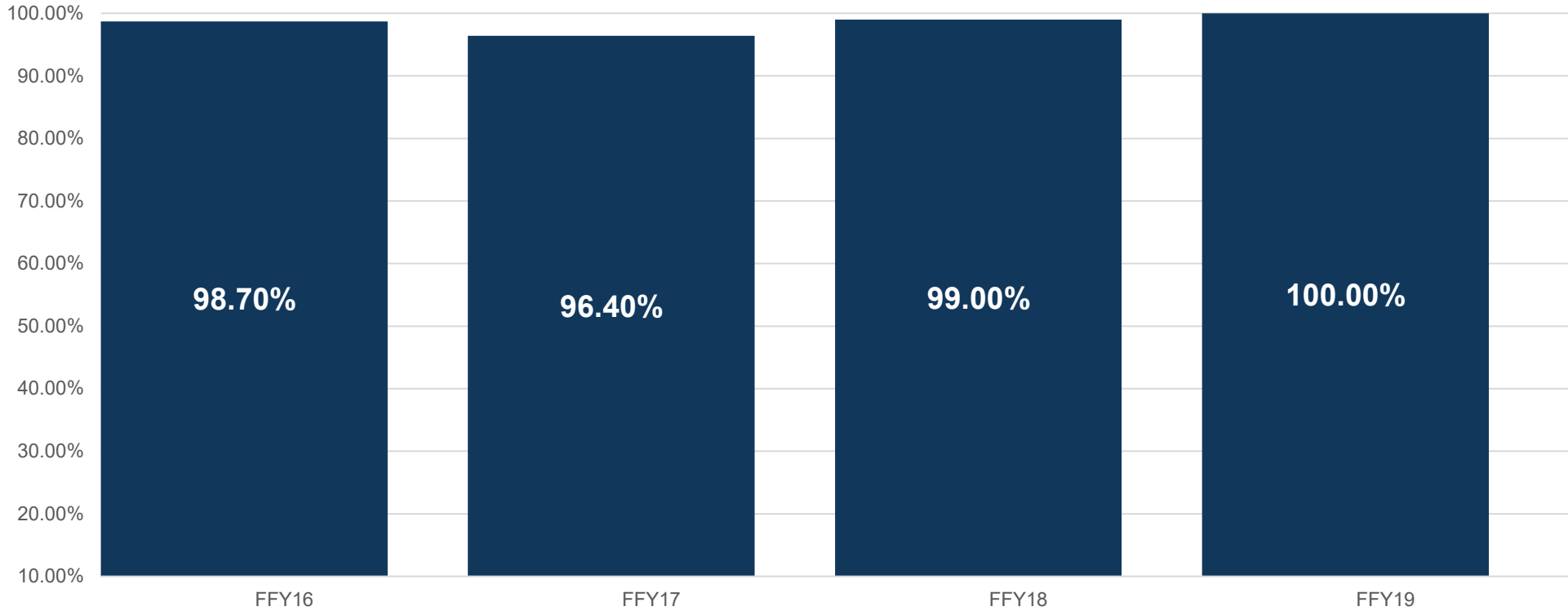
% of children with IFSPs receiving EI services in a timely manner

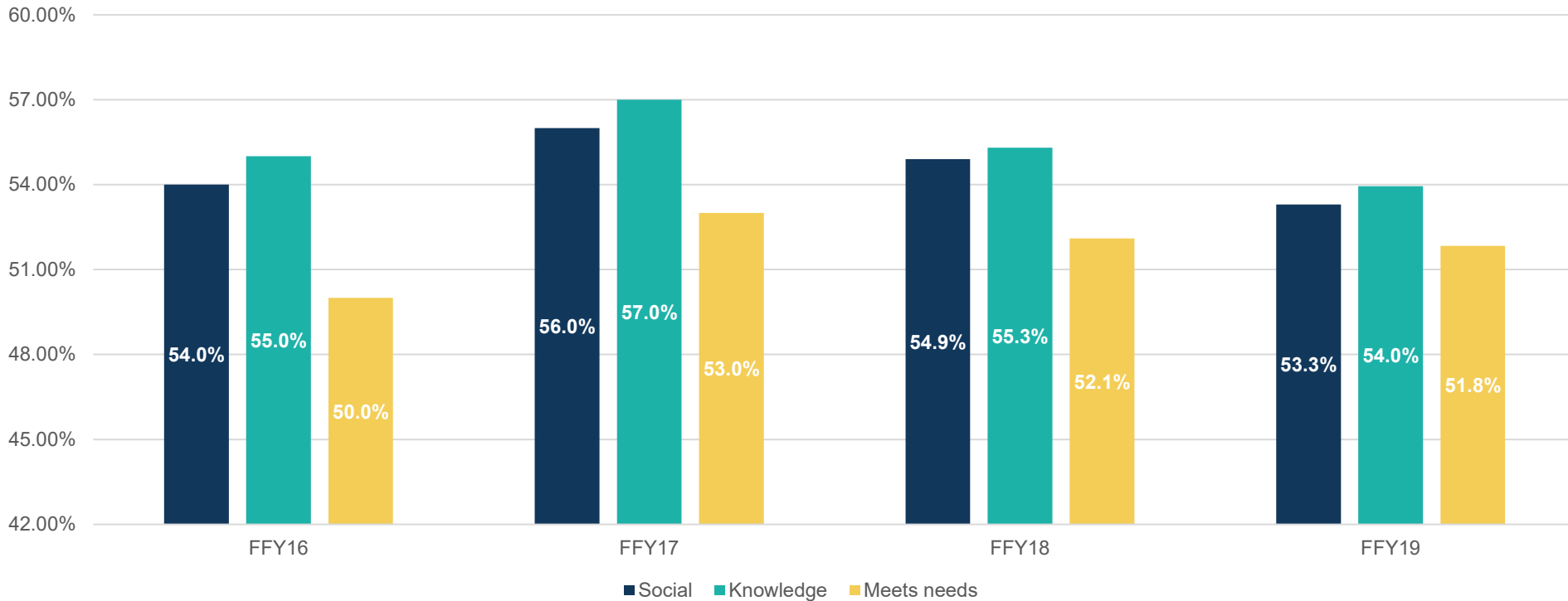

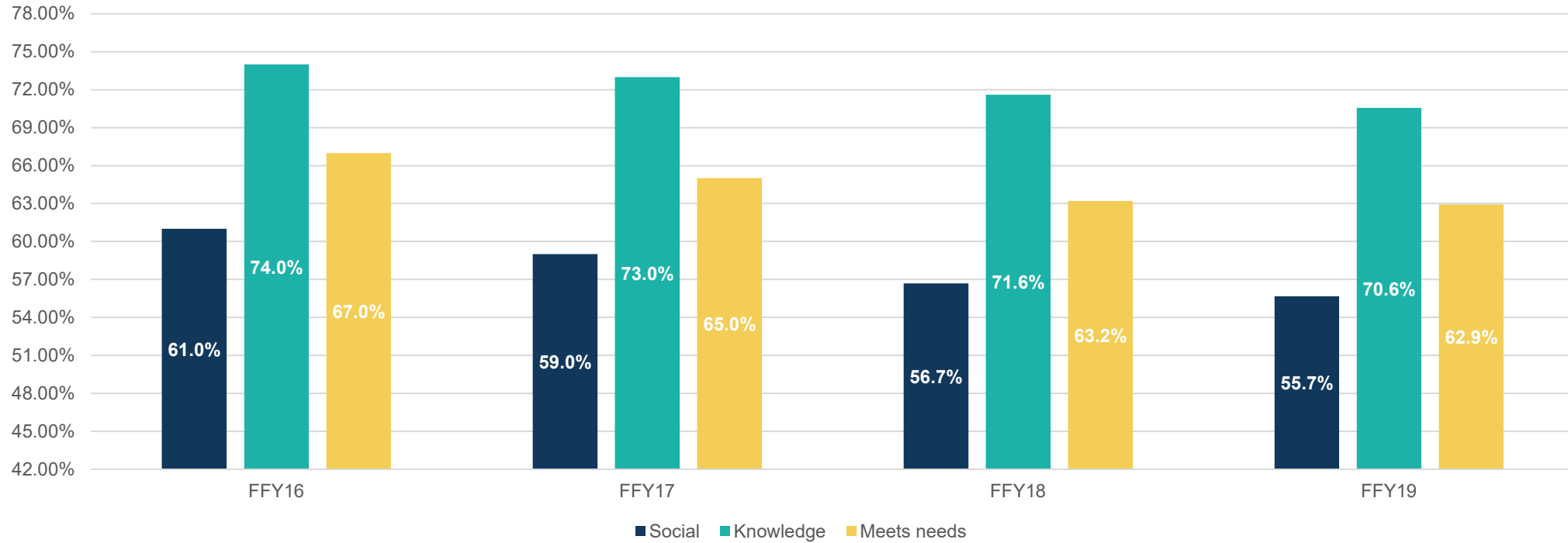
Indicator 3: Child Outcomes SS1: % of children with substantial increase in rate of growth in each outcome at exit

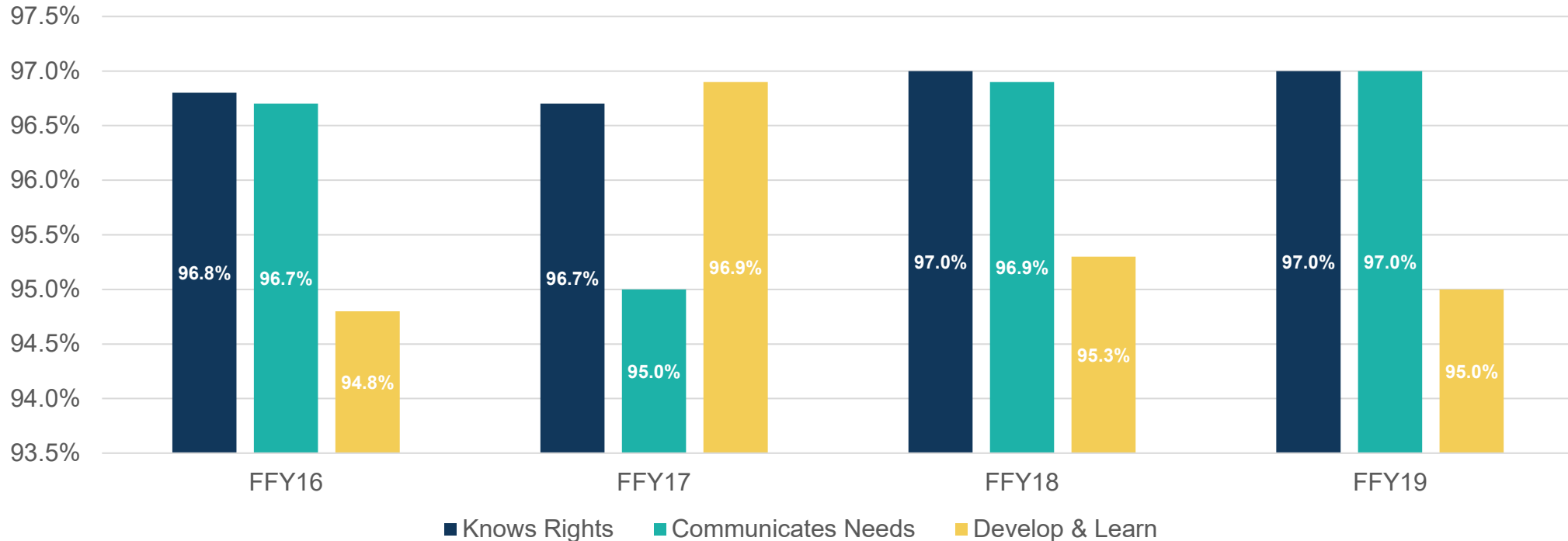

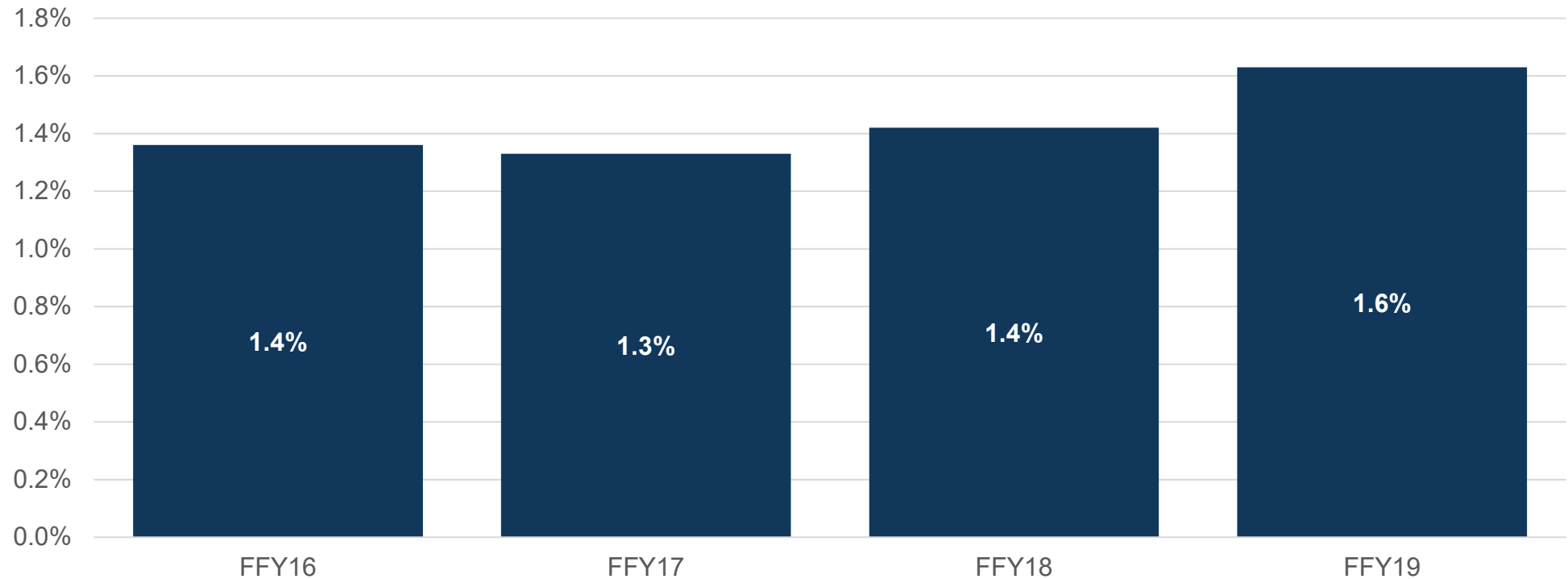
Indicator 4: Family Outcomes: % of families reporting that Early Intervention services helped the family

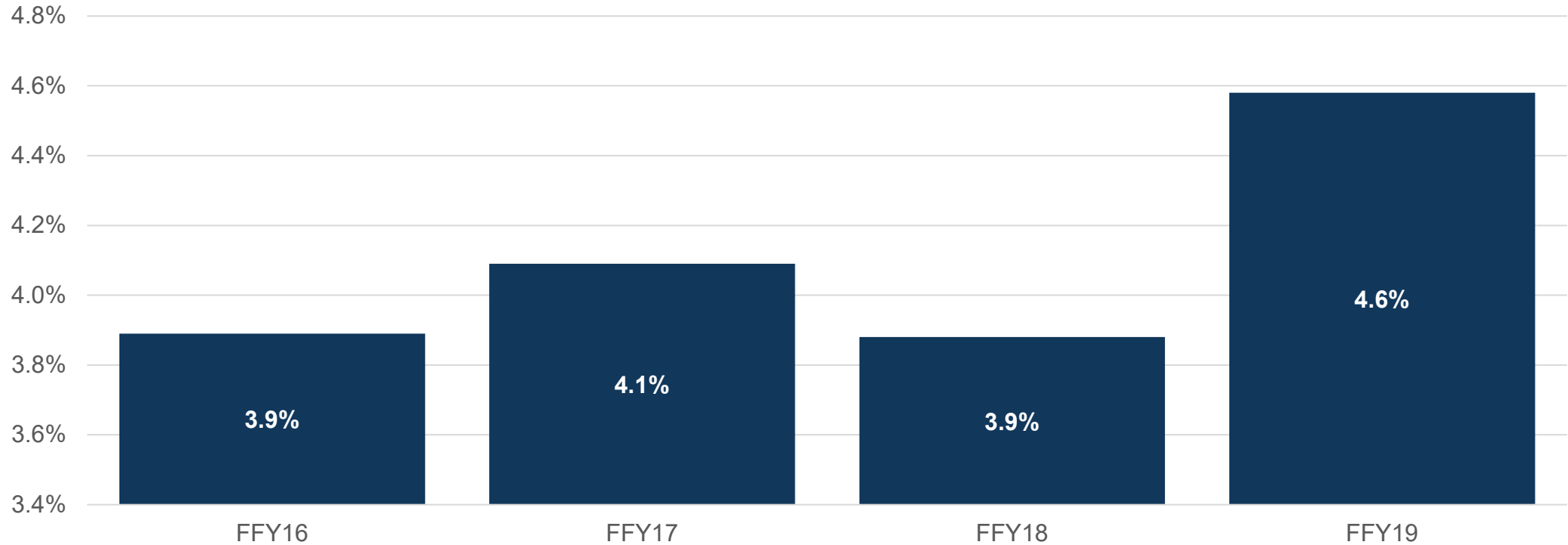

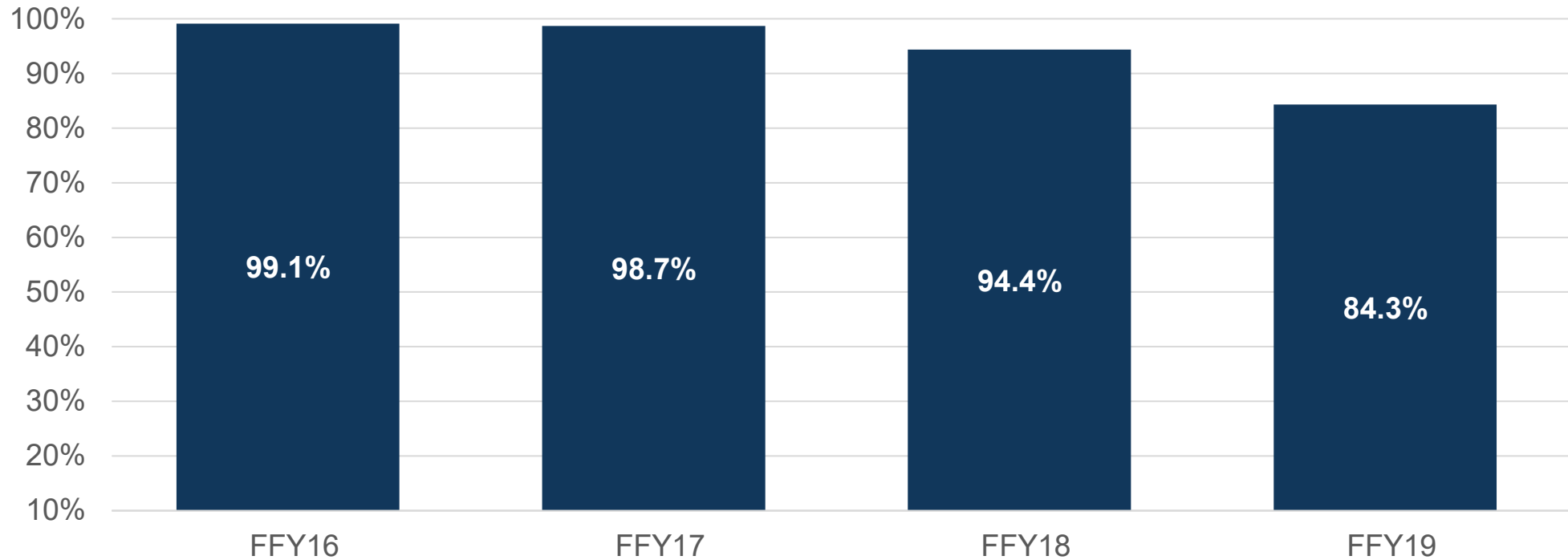
Indicator 6: % of children birth – 3 with IFSPs

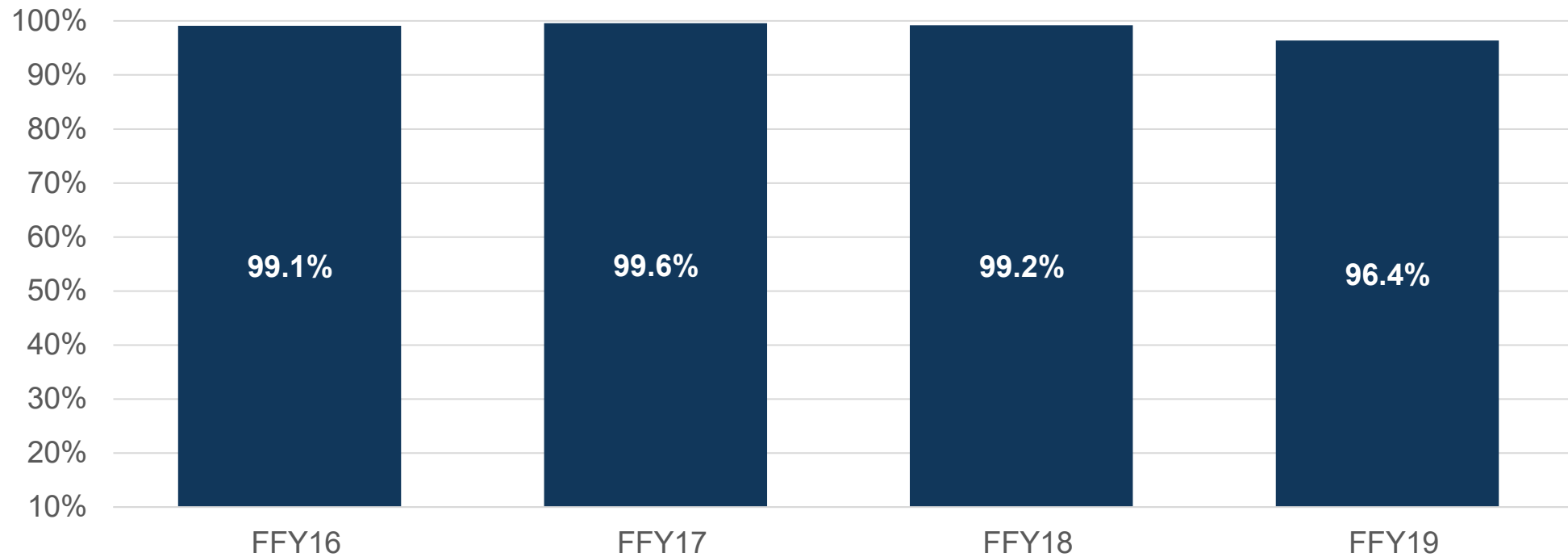
% of children with initial evaluation, assessment and IFSP meeting within 45-day timeline

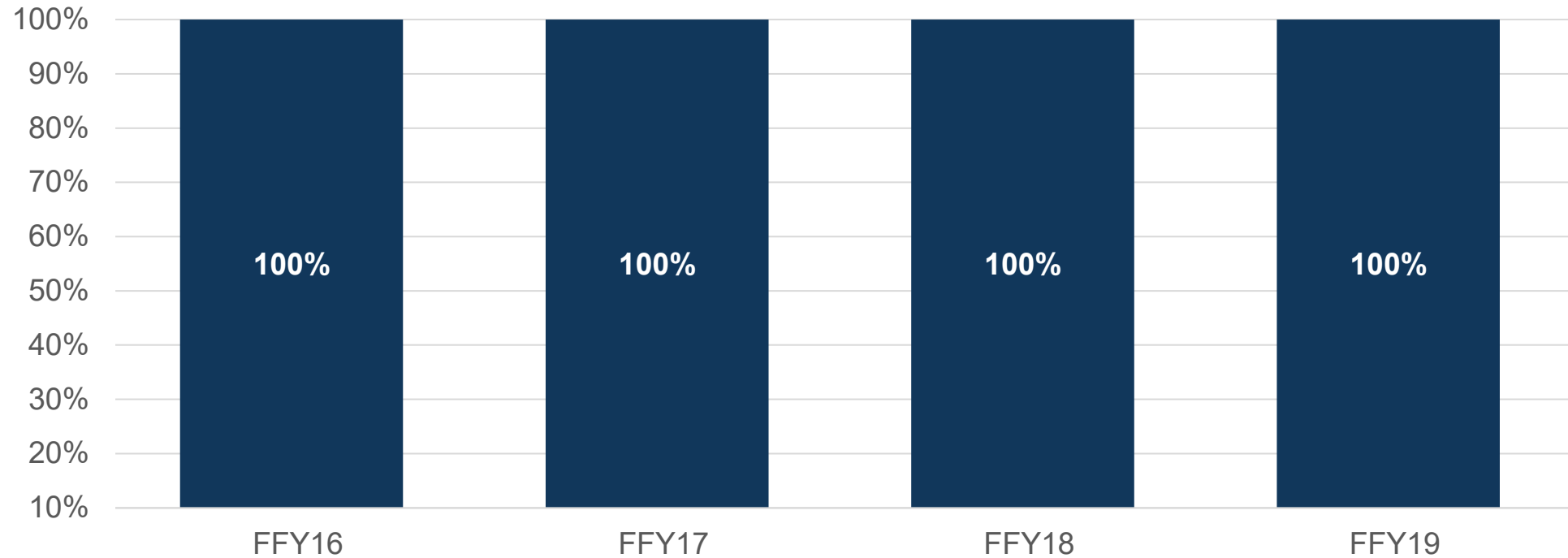

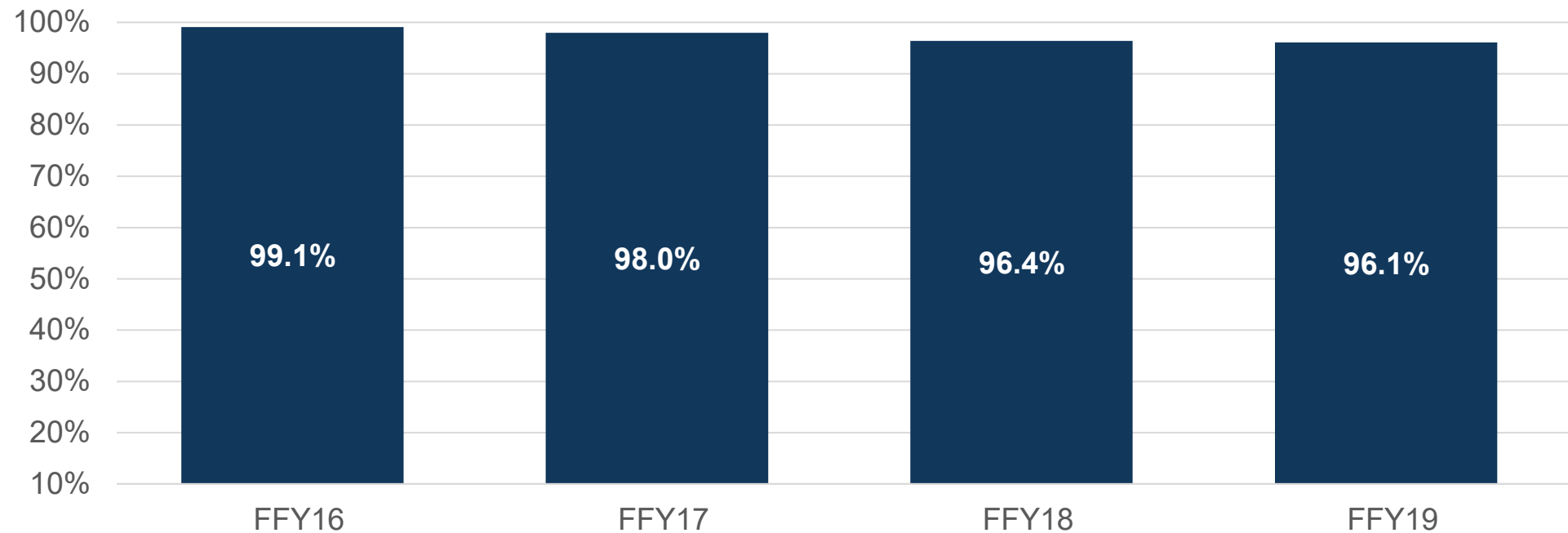
