## MISDEMEANOR PILOT PROGRAM

Recovery Works is excited to announce a new pilot program which will allow individuals with misdemeanor charges to use Recovery Works funds for treatment at qualifying, approved facilities. Qualified defendants will have access to \$1,500 for community-based treatment and \$2,500 for recovery residences for the designated misdemeanor pilot program agencies.

### REFERRAL GUIDELINES – CRIMINAL JUSTICE PARTNERS

**This pilot will follow the same process as the existing Recovery Works program, but will require a different form**

- Criminal justice partner identifies individual who qualifies for misdemeanor pilot program
- Criminal justice partner and participant fill out the “RW Misdemeanor Pilot Referral form,” selecting a provider from the list of designated misdemeanor pilot agencies
- Criminal justice partner sends referral to designated agency

### PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS

- Must not have used previous Recovery Works services.
- Is currently active in the criminal justice system with a current misdemeanor charge(s).
- At least 18 years of age.
- Resident of Indiana.
- Income does not exceed 200% of the federal poverty level.
- Does not otherwise qualify for Recovery Works (does not have a current or previous felony conviction).
- Has a substance use and/or a mental health need that will result in a diagnosis of such.
