### Past 3- & 12-month RVRs for 20 Largest Tobacco Retailers in Indiana as of October 2020

The list of companies below represent the 20 largest distributors of tobacco products in Indiana. This table represents the retailer violation rates (RVRs) of tobacco sales to minors during inspections conducted by the Indiana State Excise Police enforcing Indiana state law and FDA inspectors enforcing federal laws.

Not every company has a significant number of inspections per month. Therefore, the rates shown for each company represent three month and twelve month “rolling averages” and the number of inspections on which these averages are based. Stores are listed in order of most to least numerous in Indiana.
