**Subject:** Rate Changes and Titration

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update regarding recent changes to Recovery Works recovery residence and titration processes. Please remember that billing Tiers are separate and distinct from the Certified Designated Recovery Residence Levels. Please note that all changes are effective **January 1, 2026**.

Below is a summary of the upcoming changes:

**Recovery Residence Billing Levels – SFY 26**

| <u>Tier</u> | <u>Price</u> | <u>Meals Provided</u> | <u>All Prescribed Medication Accepted</u> |
|-------------|--------------|-----------------------|---|
| <b>A</b>    | \$26         | No                    | No  |
| <b>B</b>    | \$30         | Yes                   | No  |
| <b>C</b>    | \$34         | Yes                   | Yes                                       |

**Tier A:** Minimal support offered – Room only, does not provide food, and does not allow for all medications

**Tier B:** Offers meals, but restricts some prescribed medications

**Tier C:** Provides comprehensive support, including meals, and allows all prescribed medication

**Recovery works Titration Schedule**

- All titration begins on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month after the participant has reached their milestone.
  - *Example: A participant begins treatment on January 15<sup>th</sup>. Their 90 days of full RW payment ends April 15<sup>th</sup>. The participant will begin titration on May 1<sup>st</sup>.*



- Participants who have previously utilized Recovery Works services will receive 30 days of recovery residence services at no cost, then begin titration at month 4.
- Participants who transition from a recovery residence to a higher level of care (due to relapse) may return to the same recovery residence within 45 days without the need for a new referral.
  - *Participant titration will pick up where he/she left off prior to leaving.*
