**Subject:** Rate Changes and Titration

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide updates to the Recovery Works Referral Process. The new referral process took effect **October 16, 2025**.

**Referral Updates**

- Recovery Works has implemented a web-based referral process. All referrals are submitted at <https://pacerecoveryworks.org>. Status updates are also provided on this portal.
- Referrals may be submitted only by a Criminal Justice Partner or by the participant. No other entities are permitted to submit referrals on behalf of participants.
- An acceptance letter is no longer required before submitting a referral. All referrals must begin with a referral request. Recovery Works will then distribute the referral to multiple agencies for acceptance.

**Incarcerated Referrals**

- Referrals for incarcerated individuals may be submitted up to one (1) year prior to release. Referrals submitted during incarceration remain valid for 30 days post-release at the same provider location(s).
- A jail or prison face sheet is an acceptable form of identification for individuals who are currently incarcerated.
