The Commission is the advisory board for Indiana's Vocational Rehabilitation Services, which serves thousands of citizens with disabilities each year through vocational rehabilitation, employment, education and independent living in the community.

About the Commission

Appointed by the Governor, members of Indiana's Commission on Rehabilitation Services are knowledgeable of and have concern for rehabilitation and disability issues. All members are residents of the State of Indiana and a majority of the members are people with disabilities.

Commission members represent the disability community in matters pertaining to the quality and effectiveness of Indiana's Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS). Serving in an advisory capacity, the Commission provides oversight of VRS programs, policies and procedures by:

- Partnering with VRS to develop annual goals and priorities,
- Making recommendations on program policies,
- Reviewing and providing comments on the State Plan for VRS,
- Providing funding recommendations,
- Collaborating with other Governor appointed councils,
- Increasing public awareness of disability issues such as employment, education, and independent living in the community,
- Assisting VRS staff in the administration of an annual consumer satisfaction survey,
- Monitoring and evaluating the VRS program,
- Producing an annual report that addresses the effectiveness of VRS.
