Receive, account for, and disburse funds received by the State under Part B dollars	Submit to the Commissioner such periodic reports as the Commissioner may reasonably request, and keep such records, and afford such access to such records, as the Commissioner finds necessary to verify such reports.	Submit all periodic reports and maintain records
Keep records and afford access to any records that are necessary with respect to the CIL programs	To have proper expenditures of funds and use of resources that it receives under the resource plan	To make sure there is equal access to individuals with disabilities to society and to all services, programs, activities, resources, and facilities whether public or private
Designate an agency or the organizational unit to provide services to individuals who are blind or visually impaired	Establish a method for the evaluation of the effectiveness of the Plan in meeting its objectives	Facilitate the development and achievement of IL goals selected by individuals with disabilities who seek assistance from CIL
