### CoreMMIS & Provider Portal

#### **Updates:**

- Provider Enrollment
  - Inventory peaked in July with 8,082 document
    - 742 documents in inventory as of 11/14
  - 99% of applications received closed within 14 days
- Provider Healthcare Portal
  - Delivery system now displaying
  - One-click eligibility
  - Additional delegate functions for administrative functions
- New Provider Types
  - Addiction Services (OTP) & Genetic Counselor, now available
  - ABA Therapy & Inpatient Residential Treatment Center, coming soon



## CoreMMIS & Provider Portal

#### In process:

- Rendering provider linkages
  - Newly enrolled providers, or updates to rendering-group linkages, may have erroneously end-dated.
- 1010 edit
  - Effective 1/1/2018
- 1:1 Matching Logic for Claim Submission
  - Additional research being done to clarify billing requirements for both professional and institutional billers
- Social Security Number Replacement Initiative
  - OMPP, DFR, MCEs, and CMS working together for additional details and testing to ensure compliance



# Upcoming Systems Work

- Certification of Enterprise Medicaid System (all modules)
  - Requesting CMS schedule onsite in early 2018
  - Condition for receiving enhanced match
  - Top priority
- Deferred change orders being scheduled
  - Currently have more than 120,000 hours scheduled
  - HIP and SUD work primary focus of system changes
  - Generally at capacity through end of 2018
- Two modules are up for procurement pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) and enterprise data warehouse (EDW)



# **Updates & Initiatives**

- HIP Health Plan Selection Period
  - Nov 1<sup>st</sup> Dec 15<sup>th</sup>; effective 1/1/2018. Check Eligibility!
- Non-Emergency Transportation Broker
  - Potential implementation scheduled for early-to-mid 2018
- Centralized Credentialing & Verification
  - Project continuing to progress. Estimated implementation for early-to-mid 2018
- 2017 Annual Seminar
  - 4,692 registrations, 59 sessions
- 2018 Q1 Workshops
  - 11 dates and locations throughout the state. DXC, MCEs, NEMT broker, and Conduent at each location.
- MDwise Transition
  - No changes to the MCE
