## PAROLEES UNDER SECTION 212(D)(5)

Effective October 1, 2026, per Section 71109 of the 2025 Budget Reconciliation Act individuals granted parole under Section 212(d)(5) for at least one year, are eligible for full Medicaid coverage only after they adjust to a qualified non-citizen status or meet a federal exemption (Refer to 2402.20.00).

**Note: Individuals who fail to attain or adjust to a federally qualified status should be transitioned to Emergency Services Only Medicaid coverage (ESO) (Refer to 2402.20.50).**

Verification is established by viewing USCIS Form I-94 annotated with a stamp showing granting of parole under Section 212(d)(5) of the INA and a date showing granting of parole for at least 1 year- or Form I-688B annotated "274a.12(a)(4), 274a.12(c)(11) or Form I-766 annotated "C11" or "A4".
