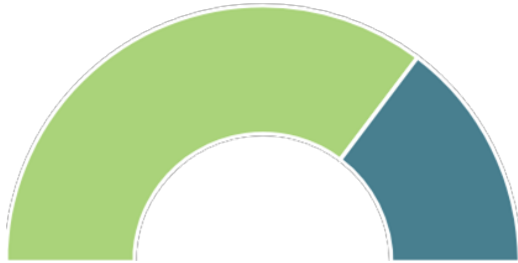


HCBS Stabilization Grant

The Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Stabilization Grants were designed to provide immediate stabilization to Indiana's workforce and community-based provider network.



20% of Indiana's HCBS Spend Plan Budget Directed Towards Stabilization

Section 9817 of the American Rescue Plan Act provides states with a temporary 10% increase to the federal medical assistance percentage (FMAP) for certain HCBS Medicaid expenditures
