Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC): Electronic Visit Verification (EVV)





Reminder: 21st Century Cures Act

- Requires providers of personal care services and home health services to use an electronic visit verification (EVV) system to document services rendered
 - Personal care services January 1, 2021*
 - Home health services January 1, 2023

*Good Faith Effort exemption delayed final implementation by one year.



Overall Requirements

- EVV captures the following details:
 - Type of service performed
 - Individual receiving the service
 - Date of the service
 - Location of service delivery
 - Individual providing the service
 - Time the service begins and ends






EVV Provider Survey Results



Survey Results

536 responses

 60% of respondents indicated they were aware of the EVV requirement.

 Nearly 60% of respondents indicated they were either not prepared or unsure if they were prepared to implement EVV.




Survey Results

- 70% of respondents indicated that they had not or were unsure if they had spoken to someone from FSSA about the EVV requirement.
- Less than 50% of respondents had indicated speaking to a vendor (either Sandata or an alternative EVV vendor) about procuring the technology necessary for EVV implementation.
