

Finding Your LinkedIn Public Profile URL

If your LinkedIn profile is set to public, it will have a web address (URL) you can use to share with others.

To find your public profile's web address:

1. Click the *Me* icon at the top of your LinkedIn homepage.
2. Click *View profile*.
3. On your profile page, click *Edit public profile & URL* on the right rail.
4. Under the section *Edit URL* in the right rail, locate your public profile URL.
 - It'll be an address that starts with www.linkedin.com/in.
5. You can copy and paste this link to share it with others.

Notes:

- This link won't appear if you don't have a [public profile](#).
- Members who live in certain countries have a public profile URL that begins with a 2-letter code based on the country listed on their profile. For example, if you live in Canada, your public profile URL could be <http://ca.linkedin.com/in/linkedinyourname>.
- If you change the country listed on your profile, your public profile URL automatically changes. The old URLs will still work.
