When we receive Letters of Guardianship, we need to make sure that the order appointing a Guardian who can act of behalf of another adult is *not only* the <u>guardian of the estate</u> *but also* the <u>guardian of the person</u> when applying for Medicaid. This is because Medicaid is a HIPAA covered program and the guardian needs to be able to make healthcare decisions on behalf of the adult.
