- Sensitivity to noise or being touched
- Always expecting something bad to happen
- Not remembering periods of your life
- Feeling emotionally numb
- Lack of concentration; irritability
- Excessive watchfulness, anxiety, anger, shame, or sadness

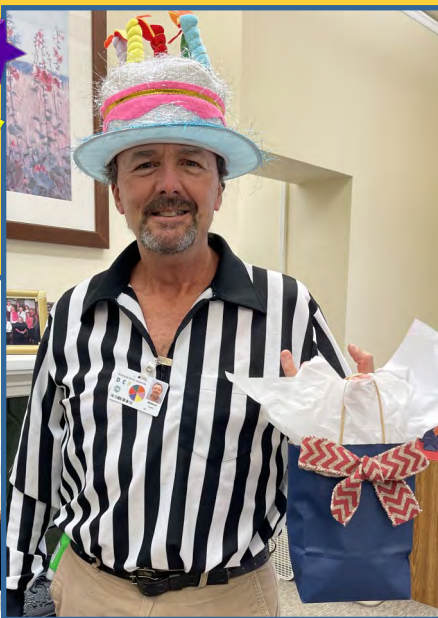
Our total for the season was \$1,436.00 which has already been sent to American Charities to be issued to the Jefferson County Youth Shelter.

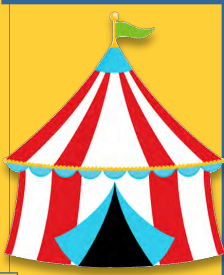
