# Why does TIC include everyone?

- Trauma informed care is about creating a culture that is directed by an understanding of the neurological, biological, psychological, and social effects of trauma and the prevalence of traumatic events in persons who seek mental health services.

## Universal Precautions: A Core TIC Concept

- Presumption that every person in a treatment setting has been exposed to traumatic experiences.

- Trauma informed care emphasizes that healing happens in relationships and in meaningful sharing of power and decision making.

- In the inpatient setting, a person may view or interact with at least a dozen staff per day including office workers, intake personnel, maintenance and environmental services, nurses, rehab therapists, social workers, interns, case managers, and direct care staff.

### Examples:



- A man will have to speak with the receptionist .
- A woman will walk past the maintenance worker on her way to the canteen.
- A family will stop at a vending machine where environmental services are working nearby.
- A child will attend his/her first treatment team meeting.

- Everyone has a role to play; one does not have to be a therapist to be therapeutic.

- Any of these staff have the opportunity to make their contact with the consumer inviting or frightening/frustrating.
