

This month Youth Services staff will be receiving official training on a new approach to enhance working with children and their families. This new approach is called the **Attachment Regulation Competency (ARC) framework**. **ARC** stands for

Attachment focuses on strengthening the caregiving system surrounding children through enhancing supports, skills, and relational resources for adult caregivers

Regulation emphasizes cultivating youth awareness and skill in identifying, understanding, tolerating, and managing internal experience

Competency addresses key factors associated with resilience in stress-impacted populations

In 2003, **Dr. Margaret Blaustein** and **Dr. Kristine Kinniburgh** co-developed **ARC** in attempt to define core aspects of trauma treatment which can be translated across service settings. **ARC** is a "flexible framework" designed with the goal of embracing the creativity and art of the clinical process while recognizing that strategies and approaches will differ across clients, across providers, and across settings.

Dr. Dr. Jon Ebert, Associate Professor of Clinical Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Vanderbilt University Medical Center and is a licensed clinical psychologist, will be presenting the training sessions April 12th-14th at the NDI. Due to the limited seating accommodations, this training is by invitation only.
