

TIC Principle #6 Historical Trauma

Historical trauma refers to the cumulative emotional and psychological wounding, as a result of group traumatic experiences that is transmitted across generations within a community. As a collective phenomenon, those who have never even experienced the trauma event or stressors, such as children and descendants, can still exhibit signs and symptoms. Marginalized groups suffer from systemic inequity in our culture (Merritt, 2021). Equal access to education, employment, health care, and social services does not exist. Racism functions in all levels of our culture; impacting intrapersonal, interpersonal, institutional, and national dynamics or relationships. Historical and racial trauma are often downplayed, underreported, or otherwise unaddressed.
