PROCLAMATION

Executive Order

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, a developmental disability in no way diminishes the right of individuals with developmental disabilities to live independently, make choices, and contribute to society; and
- WHEREAS, those with a developmental disability can fully participate in the economic, political, social, cultural, and educational mainstream of American society; and
- WHEREAS, community members with and without developmental disabilities can develop relationships and work together to make our community a place where everyone has access to needed services and amenities, embrace their community and the people who live there, and is engaged in competitive employment as part of a diverse workforce; and
- WHEREAS, and since providing individuals with developmental disabilities opportunities and support to make informed choices and decisions, live in homes and sustainable communities, exercise their full rights and responsibilities as citizens, pursue meaningful and productive lives, contribute to their family and community and achieve full inclusion in society is attainable through recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Braun, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 2026 as

DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AWARENESS MONTH
in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
