EXECUTIVE ORDER 25-78

FOR: PARDON FOR KASHINDA ROBINSON

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS.

WHEREAS, Kashinda Robinson, who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in 2013 in Marion Superior Court of Promoting Prostitution, a Class C felony, and sentenced to 706 days suspended and 24 executed, and one-year probation;

WHEREAS, the petitioner has successfully served her sentence;

WHEREAS, the petitioner has not been convicted since successfully completing her sentence over 10 years ago;

WHEREAS, the petitioner has demonstrated a total life transformation and committed herself to her mission of serving others who face challenges similar to those she has overcome;

WHEREAS, the petitioner has actively and extensively volunteered in her community dedicating substantial time to a variety of causes;

WHEREAS, the petitioner seeks to advance her career and enhance her ability to help others through professional licensure in the counseling field;

WHEREAS, family members, co-workers, community members, and members of law enforcement are supportive of petitioner receiving a pardon; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Parole Board, after careful investigation, review and examination of the facts with respect to petitioner in this matter, has unanimously recommended that the Governor issue a pardon to the petitioner.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MIKE BRAUN, Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Indiana Constitution and the laws of our State, do hereby issue a Pardon to **KASHINDA ROBINSON** for her 2013 Promoting Prostitution conviction in Marion County and it is so ordered.
