TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

WHEREAS, LARRY W. THOMPSON, JR., who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in the Union Circuit Court in 1997, at the age of 18, for criminal trespass and possession of marijuana, for which he was sentenced to a total of 60 days plus a period of probation; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, who is currently serving on active duty status in the United States Marine Corps, has received a Citation from the Secretary of the Navy for extraordinary heroism and outstanding performance in action against enemy forces in Operation Iraqi Freedom, along with numerous other commendations; and


WHEREAS, the petitioner has requested a pardon to clear his criminal record and afford himself a broader range of employment opportunities, and has stated his belief that he has paid for his mistakes and is prepared to make sound decisions and contribute in a positive way to society; and

WHEREAS, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has recommended that this pardon be granted.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of said State, do hereby issue a pardon to LARRY W. THOMPSON, JR.
