TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

WHEREAS, **BRIAN MANKIN**, who petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in Warren, Vermillion, and Vigo Counties of Operating a Vehicle with a Suspended License nine times, Unpaid Speeding Tickets between 1989 and 1995, and has been labeled a Habitual Traffic Offender; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, is now a 42 year-old man who has been a productive member of society, and works for Newell Property Services; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has been actively involved in his community, and lives in Frederick, Maryland with his wife and two children; and
