PROCLAMATION

Executive Order

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, during the first regular session of the 116th Indiana General Assembly, the General Assembly adjourned *sine die* on April 29, 2009, without fulfilling its constitutional duty to enact a budget for the 2010-2011 biennium; and

WHEREAS, the government of the State of Indiana will face grave difficulties in meeting its most fundamental responsibilities to the people of the State of Indiana, including the funding of public schools, prisons, hospitals and law enforcement, after June 30, 2009, unless a budget is enacted prior to July 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of Indiana provides in Article IV, Section 9, that the Governor may call a special session of the General Assembly by proclamation at any time, "if, in the opinion of the Governor, the public welfare shall require it" and

WHEREAS, in my opinion, the public welfare requires a special session of the 116th General Assembly.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim and call a special session of the 116th Indiana General Assembly to convene at One o'clock p.m., June 11, 2009.
