
- Bloomington-based global medical device manufacturer

What is the problem?


- Not enough single-family housing

Who needs housing help?

- First: Revisit the Problem:
 - Not enough single-family housing
 - Not enough houses that people can afford to buy
- Middle income wage earners. 60-120% AMI, may not qualify for other programs.
- Cook employees

- Rental housing (master lease, etc.)

- Education, home-ownership counseling

Let's build houses


- West Baden & French Lick
- Spencer/Owen County: 99 single-family homes
- Lot size: roughly 1/3 acre
- Price: Around \$200,000
- House: 3 bedroom, 2 bath, 2-car attached garage
- All appliances included

Electric – underground


Fiber - underground





Texas Pike Place Timeline

- December 2021: purchased property
- June 2022: plat approved
- September 2022: amended plat approval
- November 2022: Phase 1 house construction begins
- 2023: Phase 1 home closings and Phase 2 constructions begin
- April 2024: Phase 2 home closings and Phase 3 house construction begins





Texas Pike Place Timeline





How does this work?

- Partner with the local economic development leaders!
- Partner with community for infrastructure, amenities, etc.
- Build houses
- Provide education and resources to employees
- Connect employees with lenders, encourage mortgage pre-approval
- Open applications



Covenants: Workforce Housing

- Owner-occupied ONLY
- Developer right to repurchase if for sale (first 3 years)
- Developer Right of First Refusal (next 5 years)
- No HOA
