Marty Wessler, Wessler Engineering, they are currently working on the Baker-Ditch culvert and then anticipate moving to Lift Station 6, which is the Reynolds Farm Equipment up on the north end later this month as soon as the right of entries are acquired from Beck's and Reynolds Farm Equipment. We've got Duke bringing power to Lift Station 2, which is Englewood, later this month. C.J. covered McClure's and the armory. So those are all the progress updates I have at this time.

Heirbrandt stated, just so the board knows, I've reached out to schedule a meeting with INAW. There's been some inconsistencies in water delivery quantities and pressures that we've observed, and this information was delivered to them. We're trying to get some answers, and hopefully we can get answers in this upcoming meeting.

Altman inquired about a future ribbon cutting ceremony. Steve Wood stated that he will coordinate that, and the location will be at the 276<sup>th</sup> Street water tower site.
