A Public Hearing will be held March 28, 2025, for the Board of Trustees to consider implementing the new sewer and water rates for customers. Information on proposed rates and charges is provided below:

What will my monthly water and sewer bills be?

We have provided 3 scenarios to show what the monthly charges would be for a customer living in a single-family dwelling:

- o **Scenario 1**: Connected to sewer, not connected to water.
- o **Scenario 2**: Connected to water and sewer, 5/8" meter using 4,000 gallons per month
- Scenario 3: Connected to water and sewer, 5/8" meter using 7,000 gallons per month

Will I have to set up an account, apply for an exemption, or pay any fees if I am not connected to water or sewer?

NO.

Only the customers who have a water and/or sewer main installed along their property line will be given the notice to apply for a connection or an exemption.

Only the customers who physically connect to the water and/or sewer systems will need to have an account set up and be responsible for any fees and a monthly bill.

All other property owners living within the District boundaries do not need to do anything.
