### 1. If entering Indianapolis from I-65 South (heading south):

From I-65 South, take I-70 East to the Keystone exit and go north. Stay on Keystone until East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left (west) onto East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay on East 38<sup>th</sup> Street until College Avenue. Turn right (north) onto College Avenue. Turn right (east) at East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Stay on East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street until you see the school on the left.

## 2. If entering Indianapolis from I-65 North (heading north):

From I-65 North, take I-70 East to the Keystone exit and go north. Stay on Keystone until East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left (west) onto East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay on East 38<sup>th</sup> Street until College Avenue. Turn right (north) onto College Avenue. Turn right (east) at East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Stay on East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street until you see the school on the left.

### 3. If entering Indianapolis from I-69 (heading south):

I-69 will become Highway 37 South/Binford Boulevard/Fall Creek Parkway. Turn right (west) at East 46<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay on East 46<sup>th</sup> Street until you reach Ralston Avenue. Turn left (south) onto Ralston Avenue. Stay on Ralston Avenue until you reach East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Turn right (west) onto 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. The school will be on the right. (There will also be green and white signs directing you to the Indiana School for the Deaf.)

### 4. If entering Indianapolis from I-70 East (heading east)

From I-70 East, take the Keystone exit and go north. Stay on Keystone until East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left (west) onto East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay on East 38<sup>th</sup> Street until College Avenue. Turn right (north) onto College Avenue. Turn right (east) at East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Stay on East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street until you see the school on the left.

### 5. If entering Indianapolis from I-70 West (heading west):

From I-70, take the Keystone Avenue exit and go north. Stay on Keystone until to East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left (west) onto 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay on 38<sup>th</sup> Street until College Avenue. Turn right (north) onto College Avenue. Turn right (east) at East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Stay on East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street until you see the school on the left.

### 6. If entering Indianapolis from I-74 East (heading east):

From I-74 East, take I-465 South to I-65 North to I-70 East. From I-70 East, take the Keystone exit and go north. Stay on Keystone until East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left (west) onto East 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay on East 38<sup>th</sup> Street until College Avenue. Turn right (north) onto College Avenue. Turn right (east) at East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Stay on East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street until you see the school on the left.

### 7. If entering Indianapolis from I-74 West (heading west):

From I-74, take I-465 North to the 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Exit at 38<sup>th</sup> Street and go right (east). Stay on 38<sup>th</sup> Street for about 10 miles. Turn left (north) onto College Avenue. Turn right (east) onto East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. Stay on East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street until you see the school on the left.

Arriving on ISD campus/parking at the Center:

The Center for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Education is located in the Eliza Willard Assessment Center and Raney South building (*see campus map*).

When entering onto ISD campus, you may be stopped at the guard shack. Inform security that you are visiting the Center for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Education- if you tell them the building (Raney South OR EWAC) they may be able to direct you for parking. You may be asked to show ID and receive a visitor badge. If the gate is up or you are waved through, here are directions to find our locations:

# If visiting the Center in the <u>Raney South Building</u>:

Raney South building is right of the main road onto campus- the first building you see on the right as you enter through the gate. When you enter past guard shack, take an immediate right. Visitor parking is available on the left in front of the building. These visitor spots are in the small area of the parking lot just off the main road. If these spots are full, you can park in the larger lot just north of 42<sup>nd</sup> street and the state fairgrounds.

Enter Raney South on the west side of the building- closest to the visitor parking in the small lot. Enter the building through the glass doors. There is a bell to ring for entrance to the building. If no one answers the bell, please go over to EWAC for assistance.

## If visiting the Center in the Eliza Willard Assessment Center (EWAC):

Once past the guard shack, take an immediate right (following the white signs with our logo). Go down the parking lot past the Raney South building (on your left). EWAC will be just past that building. There is visitor parking just outside the building. There is a bell to ring for entrance to the building.
