Durable Medical Equipment Criteria

Latest Revision Date: January 1, 2023

Criteria:

- The Participant's CSHCS physician must have prescribed the item.
- Item must be essential for the Participant's long-term rehabilitation and/or to prevent regression, of an eligible medical condition (excluding Wheelchairs & Safety Seating Devices).
- Item must be durable and adaptable for long-term use, when appropriate.
- Item must be physically and developmentally appropriate for the Participant's safety.
- Item's use must be planned primarily to serve a medical purpose rather than for transportation (excluding Wheelchairs & Safety Seating Devices), comfort or convenience.
- Item must be a cost effective equipment/treatment for meeting the Participant's medically eligible needs.
- Item must require no architectural modifications of a dwelling or property.
- Equipment repair is preferred in lieu of replacement, <u>unless</u> replacement more cost-effective.
- Repair or replacement of malfunctioning equipment under warranty <u>shall not be authorized by CSHCS</u> (warranty/guarantee must be used for repair or replacement).
- Lost or broken equipment will <u>only</u> be replaced at the normal equipment life expectancy interval, regardless of whether CSHCS purchased the item lost or broken.
- Item will <u>not</u> be a duplicate or back-up equipment.
