

Title: Out-of-State Care

Out-of-State Care Procedure

Purpose: To establish guidelines for care at Out-of-State Providers.

Rule References:

410 IAC 3.2-7-1(a) – The director shall select and approve... to provide health care services...
410 IAC 3.2-7-1(d) – Health care services ... may be provided outside of Indiana if the director determines that the specific ... service is not readily available within... Indiana

Policy:

Since Out-of-State care is no more expensive than In-State care (Medicaid approved rate), <u>or</u> more reasonably available to Participants due to proximity, <u>or</u> some services may not be readily available In-State, Out-of-State providers have been included in the "Health Care Delivery System" and care from these providers is deemed appropriate and shall be provided when:

- A. An appropriate Out-of-State CSHCS approved provider is located within the geographic proximity of the Participant's home, or
- B. The examination and/or treatment, which are related to a Participant's approved medical condition, can't be obtained with the same assurance or ease within Indiana.
