## Two types of CHEMPACK containers

#### **EMS** containers

- Geared to first responder field use
- 85% auto injectors
- 454 casualty capacity

#### **Hospital containers**

- Geared to clinical care environment
- 85% multi-dose vials, must be reconstituted
- 1,000 casualty capacity

# **Events that warrant opening the CHEMPACK**

Any of the following events, after local resources are exhausted.

- Accident with organophosphate pesticides
  - At farm or industry
  - o In transport
- Terrorism event with nerve agent exposure
  - Possible agents: Sarin, Soman,
    Tabun, & VX
