


Emergency Numbers at Public Pools Indiana Interpretation of 410 IAC 6-2.1-34(e):

Indiana State Department of Health Rule 410 IAC 6-2.1-34(e) requires a telephone to be located within two hundred (200) feet of the pool enclosure and must be available for emergency use whenever the pool is open for use, with the facility location and the following emergency telephone numbers posted within view:

- (1) 911.
- (2) Ambulance or rescue unit.
- (3) Hospital.
- (4) Police station.
- (5) Fire department.

It is the policy of the Indiana State Department of Health that where 911 service is available only the 911 needs to be posted to meet the requirements of the rule. A phone set up to auto dial "911" when the receiver is picked up, is also acceptable.
