WELCOME

Dr. Buyer, Chair IOHC opened the meeting at 10:02 a.m. with a drawing game that highlighted collaboration. She welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming. She shared a poem with them. She said that we are here as coalition members to collaborate and communicate and to achieve our goals. It takes all of our experiences together to build a program that Hoosiers will need to achieve oral health and wellness. Our mission, of course, is to serve as a collective voice of individuals, groups, organizations, and businesses working together to promote, protect, and provide for the oral health of the residents of Indiana. At our French Lick meeting, the 2009 Strategic Oral Health Initiative (SOHI) Project Report was unanimously adopted. As a guideline, the members voted to prioritize the eleven goals established by the SOHI. The highest priority goal was to develop an oral health surveillance system. The next highest goal was to advocate for Medicaid and oral health. After these came providing for a competent and diverse workforce, promoting community water fluoridation and promoting dental students' involvement in community oral health. The speakers today will cover various topics on conducting an oral health survey as the first step in supporting the development of an oral health surveillance system. We may want to incorporate some of the ideas presented today into any survey on oral health Indiana may conduct in the future.

REVIEW MINUTES

Dr. Buyer asked if there was a motion to accept the minutes of the French Lick meeting. A motion and second were offered and the Indiana Oral Health Coalition minutes from the June 10, 2011, meeting were approved as submitted by a unanimous voice vote.

Again, the top two goals are conducting an oral health survey among children in Indiana and supporting Medicaid as it relates to dental care.

Dr. Buyer acknowledged the Dental Hygiene Class that was in attendance. Melinda Meadows explained that this was her Advanced Community Dental Hygiene class and that they were licensed dental hygienists studying for their Bachelor's degree. They were attending today's meeting to see the important work that the IOHC is doing.
