We did not fill out section IV since 2016 was ICD 10. There was no breakout codes for HIV in ICD10 so I had to put 0. For ICD 10 under Other/Known I combined diseases of the eye and adnexa, diseases of the ear and mastoid process, symptoms signs and abnormal clinical and lab findings not elsewhere classified, and factors influencing health status and contact with health services.
