

Readopted Final Rule
LSA Document #24-588

Readopts rules in anticipation of IC 4-22-2.6, providing that an administrative rule adopted under IC 4-22-2 expires January 1 of the fifth year after the year in which the rule takes effect unless the rule contains an earlier expiration date. Effective 30 days after filing with the publisher.

SUMMARY/RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) requested public comment from September 10, 2025, through October 10, 2025. The IDOH received one (1) comment in response to the Notice of Public Comment Period for Rule Readoption.

Commentor: Robert S. Bradshaw, Institute of Inspection Cleaning and Restoration Certification (IICRC)

Comment: Robert S. Bradshaw suggested that the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) adopt the American National Standard's Institute/Institute of Inspection, Cleaning, and Restoration Certification (ANSI/IICRC) S900 Standard to address evolving risks presented by illicit drug use, manufacturing, and contamination, especially in response to the growing prevalence of fentanyl. Mr. Bradshaw's comment pertains to 410 IAC 38, INSPECTION AND CLEANUP OF PROPERTY CONTAMINATED WITH CHEMICALS USED IN THE ILLEGAL MANUFACTURE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.

Response: IDOH appreciates the comment and will consider the suggestion should the rule be revised in the future, but at this time will be readopting the rules without modification.
