

1. Admission to L&D or Postpartum Unit – Educate About NBS

A. The Labor and Delivery/Postpartum staff reviewed the following education with the family and obtained dried blood spot (DBS) storage consent status:

- Staff reviewed the PHG NBS *What to Know After Your Baby Arrives* handout with the family
- Staff reviewed the *After Newborn Screening* handout with the family
- Family signed, dated and chose consent option “yes” or “no” on the back of the NBS card

2. Perform NBS and Document Outcomes

B. The following screens were performed, written on the NBS card and documented in the EMR:

Dried Blood Spot Screen

- The initial screen was performed and the back of the NBS card was completed by the family.

Critical Congenital Heart Defect Screen

- A screen was performed with passing scores - *see below for reference*
- The screen had failing scores and repeat screen and/or echocardiogram was completed

Note: if the scores reflect what is in the green box to the left, nothing further is needed. If the scores reflect what is in either the yellow or red box to the left, an echo needs performed ASAP.</p>
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Hearing Screen

- Patient passed screen with/without risk factors
- Patient did not pass screen and a referral for audiology was made

C. Report all required information to the PHG program and NBS Laboratory:

- If patient qualified as an exception to NBS, this has been reported on the MSR or this information has been sent to your facility’s designated MSR submitter
- If family refused NBS due to religious beliefs, [State Form 54102](#) has been completed by family and sent to PHG
- [NBS Lab Change of Information Form](#) was completed and sent to NBS Laboratory to update name/other info
