Dear Program Participant,

You are receiving this letter because you are enrolled in the Indiana Department of Health's **HIV Services Program – AIDS Drug Assistance Program/Early Intervention Program (ADAP/EIP)**. This program helps pay for HIV-related medical care and prescriptions. It is designed as a bridge program to support you while you work toward obtaining full coverage health insurance.

Federal law requires that Ryan White Program services be used **only when no other insurance options are available**. This means you must apply for any public or private health insurance you qualify for before you can continue using ADAP/EIP services.

As part of this requirement, the **2027 Open Enrollment Period (Nov. 1, 2026 – Jan. 15, 2027)** includes several important steps you must take to maintain program eligibility.

#### **Required actions for ADAP/EIP clients:**

All ADAP/EIP clients must apply for:

- **Health Insurance Assistance Program (HIAP)**
- **Medicaid**, if your household income is **at or below 138% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)**

Your case manager will help you determine which programs you qualify for and assist you through the application process.

#### **What you need to do:**

- Work with your case manager to apply for **HIAP** before **Jan. 15, 2027**
- If your income qualifies, complete an application for **Medicaid** with your case manager's support

It is very important that you complete these steps. If you do not apply for HIAP and, when required, Medicaid **by Jan. 15**, your ADAP/EIP coverage will end on **Jan. 31, 2027**. If your coverage ends, you will not be able to reenroll until you provide proof that you have applied for both HIAP and Medicaid. Please contact your case manager as soon as possible to begin your applications and avoid any disruption in your medication or medical care.
