Condition Name in NBS:

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**

Non-NBS users: Report using

- **REDCap Form** -OR-
- Fax a communicable disease form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Neisseria gonorrhoeae by culture, minimally with isolation of typical gram-negative, oxidase-positive diplococci
- *N. gonorrhoeae* by nucleic acid amplification (e.g., Polymerase Chain Reaction [PCR]) or hybridization with a nucleic acid probe
- Gram-negative intracellular diplococci in a urethral or an endocervical smear

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Within the NBS Morbidity Report:
 - Patient information (as much as possible)
 - Facility and Provider information
 - Clinical information
 - Epidemiological information: **Pregnancy status**
 - Lab Report and Treatment information

Additional Documentation to Include

- Indicate in Comments if disseminated infection, treatment failure, or antibiotic resistance are suspected
- Optional: Add medical record notes as attachments
