- Rapid Hepatitis C test results can be reported with <u>this form</u>
- Providers can report cases with this form
- All others can report with this form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive Anti-HCV (including rapid tests)
- Positive and Negative Nucleic Acid Amplification Test (NAAT, such as PCR) for hepatitis C virus RNA
- HCV Genotype test

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, epidemiologic, pregnancy status, lab report, and treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report
- Available information on patient symptoms, including jaundice

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (Hepatic Panel and/or Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)
- Applicable patient medicals records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history
