Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report via Fax to **317-233-7663** with **this form**

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive hepatitis D antibody testing
- Positive and negative HDV RNA (including quantitative and qualitative)
- Any additional Hepatitis B and/or D serological results (positive or negative)

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical Epidemiological, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report
- Available information on patient symptoms, including jaundice

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (Hepatic Panel and/or Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)
- Applicable patient medicals records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history
- Any noted hepatitis B vaccination history
