#### Step 2:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with this form

### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

• Bacterial isolation of *Bacillus anthracis*, demonstration antigens by immunohistochemistry (IHC), detection of antibodies by serology, detection of *B. anthracis* or anthrax toxin genes by LRN-validated polymerase chain reaction (PCR), or LF mass spectrometry

# **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

- Contact the Vector-Borne and Zoonotic Disease Program (business hours) or the epidemiologist oncall (after hours) immediately to report
- Complete Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report

# **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries
- Travel history, known animal or potential unpasteurized dairy exposures (imported cheeses, raw milk), and lab exposures
- Name and contact information of follow-up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report
