Condition Name:

Arboviral Disease or Infection, Domestic

Condition Name in NBS:

- West Nile Virus, Neuroin vasive/Non Neuroinvasive
- St. Louis Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Eastern Equine Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Western Equine Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive

- California Serogroup Virus Diseases

TO REPORT:

- Immediately Reportable: complete steps 1-2
- Within One Working Day: complete step 2

Step 1: Call 317-233-7125

Step 2:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

Reporting Timeframe:

- Immediately Reportable Eastern Equine Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Within One Working Day All other Arboviral Diseases listed above

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Isolation of virus from, or demonstration of specific viral antigen or nucleic acid in, tissue, blood, CSF, or other body fluid, EIA , virus-specific quantitative antibody titers.
- Virus-specific IgM antibodies in CSF or serum *If positive, forward to IDOH Labs for further testing.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within NBS morbidity report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries, recent travel history.
- Negative results for other arboviral IgM antibodies in CSF or serum
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
